Harvested September 17, 2025

The Albariño from Martian Vineyard was a relatively small crop. The grapes came in perfectly ripe with 13% potential alcohol.

The grapes were whole-cluster pressed then fermented in neutral French barrels. The juice, or must as we call it, had gorgeous aromatics and I decided to arrest the malo-lactic fermentation. This was done at about 30%.

The resulting wine has effusive aromas of lime blossoms and fresh herbs including lemon thyme followed by flavors of white and freestone peaches finishing with bright, citrusy flavors layered with white stone minerals and hints of bitter almonds.

This wine is meant for coastal cuisine including fish and shellfish, creamy young cheeses or delicate poultry and vegetable dishes. Also great as an aperitif with oysters a traditional pairing in Galicia, Spain.
