ABOUT FIGHTING PRETTY

Fighting Pretty was founded on the idea that we are women, not just cancer patients, and we are more than our cancer. The organization's mission is to help women battling cancer feel strong annd beautiful. we strive to empower them so they know they are not alone and can look at themselves in the mirror and see a strong, amazing, fierce, beautiful woman.

Our founder, Kara Frazier, was diagnosed with Stage 3 breast cancer at age 26. Despite undergoing chemotherapy, radiation, double mastectomy, and more, it was two special items —hot pink lipstick and a pair of gifted mini pink boxing gloves—that helped her feel strong and beautiful.

Once Kara completed her treatment, she wanted to share her strength. She passed on her gloves to five other women battling various types of cancer, and Fighting Pretty was born.



Since 2013, Fighting Pretty has made a significant impact, reaching over 48,000 women across all 50 US states and 30 countries worldwide. Our efforts have been recognized on esteemed platforms such as the Today Show, the New York Stock Exchange, and have even been featured in campaigns by Gap Body and Ulta Beauty.

A WORD FROM OUR FOUNDER

After 11 strong years as a non-profit organization, I am honored and excited about what we have accomplished over the years.

Back in 2013 when Fighting Pretty began as just idea, I never could have imagined the impact we have been able to make across the globe. However, one thing has never changed: our mission. We have always been committed to helping women feel strong and beautiful through their cancer journey.

This past year was no different. We continue to be nimble in our operations and our structure. We currently have a total of five working moms who are dedicated to the mission and empower our community to stay strong, feel beautiful and remember they are not alone.

Plus, there are now a total of four Student Ambassador Groups across the USA who are running their own "Fighting Pretty" organizations on campus and helping women battling cancer in their communities. Fighting Pretty is giving these young women the experience they need for their careers and the leadership and empathetic experience that can use for a lifetime. The impact of Fighting Pretty goes beyond just the patients we help, it spreads to their cancer care teams, families, friends, volunteers, donors and anyone who interacts with this mission.

Each member of the Fighting Pretty team has driven past cars in Oregon, Indiana and New Jersey on many occasions and have seen pink gloves hanging from rearview mirrors. My sister met a stranger at the Jersey Shore wearing a Fighting Pretty t-shirt and my uncle encountered an old friend with a Fighting Pretty koozie at the beach. The movement is spreading and we couldn't be more honored to know we are truly making a difference.

By remaining true to our mission, we continue to send individual Pretty Packages to women across the globe and through our Strength and Beauty Program, we are able to work with other non-profits and cancer care teams to reach women at their most vulnerable state. Each year, we expand how we engage with our community and in 2024 launched our first ever "Pretty Powerful Girls Day Out" Fundraiser in collaboration with Thrive Causemetics to not only pamper women in attendance, but raise money to fund our programs. Let's just say it was Pretty darn Powerful!

In 2024, we helped more women battling cancer than any year prior, but until cancer is eradicated, we have a lot of work to do. We are so thankful for our amazing community who gives us the strength we need so we can send on the strength to women who need it most!



The Strength and Beauty Program is at the heart of our mission and truly enables us to reach more women battling all types of cancer at all different stages of cancer treatment. Each of our Strength & Beauty Kits contains our signature Gloves of Strength, a paraben-free lip product, and information about ways women can get connected and join the Flghting Pretty community. These Kits are small but powerful reminders to women in active treatment that they are strong, beautiful, and part of a nation-wide community of support and encouragement.





in 2024, we set a goal to help over 8,000 women by sending our Strength & Beauty Kits top hospitals, cancer clinics and other cancer-focused nonprofits across the globe.



Pretty Powerful - Girls Day Out

Fighting Pretty introduced a new signature event to not only support women battling cancer, but invite the community for a day of pampering, treats, and empowerment. Our annual "Pretty Powerful - Girls Day Out Fundraiser" was hosted in collaboration with Thrive Causemetics where we hosted 60 women at The Oregon Golf Club, connected with our community and raised funds to support our mission.







Fighting Pretty community member Aubrey Kyung spoke about her cancer experience and how her mindset has impacted her journey. Plus, one of our favorite activites at the event was being able to provide a Thrive Causmetics-branded Lipstick Bar! Two staff members from Thrive Causemetics provided assistence to attendees to find their perfect lipstick shade with generously donated lip products of all new colors. Each attendee left with one or two brand new lip products.

In addition, we hosted eight Portland-based small business vendors providing products and services to remind women they are strong and beautiful.

Each woman was greeted at the door with a mocktail or cocktail and there were tasty bites, incredible raffle prizes and a beautiful day of comradery and pampering.

Annual Holiday Pack-a-thon

Fighting Pretty has hosted dozens of Packing Parties over the last 11 years and typically we create hundreds of Strength & Beauty Kits or Pretty Packages with the help of volunteers.

As an end to our Giving Tuesday fundraising efforts and kick off to end of year giving, we opted to host a Holiday Pack-A-Thon inviting our community to and volunteer their time and pack 2,000 Strength & Beauty Kits.

Hosted at our Fighting Pretty Headquarters in December, over 40 community members joined us for a holiday-themed brunch and celebration of Fighting Pretty's 2024 impact.

Kris Lugo, a survivor and woman who is truly Fighting Pretty, was celebrated and honored alongside her family and supporters.

In just over two hours, our staff and volunteers packed over 2,000 Strength & Beauty Kits to be sent out to 17 hospitals and treatment centers over the next couple of months. These Kits included our signature Gloves of Strength along with Burt's Bee's lip products donated by Ulta Beauty.




