The ladies' Care team is led by June Dhanabalan and Annie Koh. They coordinate all the lunch fellowships.



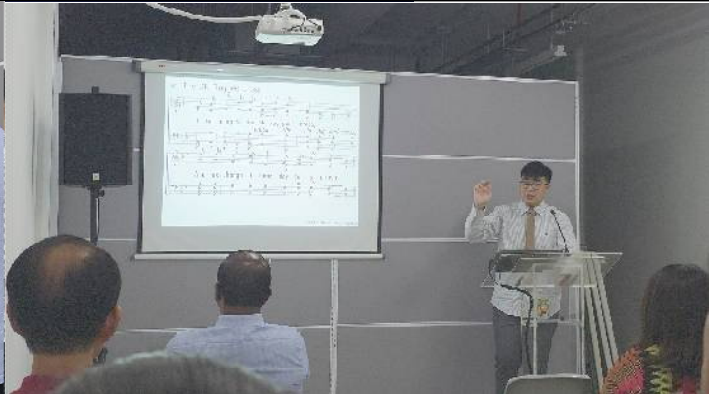
Henry Kong and Paul Poon lead the Youth Care team.

Care teams meet at 10am, before the worship. They check in on each other, discuss the previous week's sermon and pray for each other.

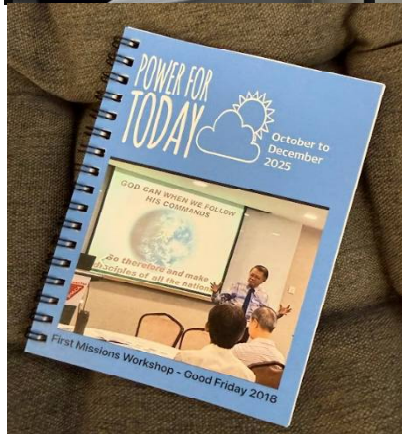
All members attend the Care team to get to know one another and grow in faith. We welcome you, your friends and family to join us.

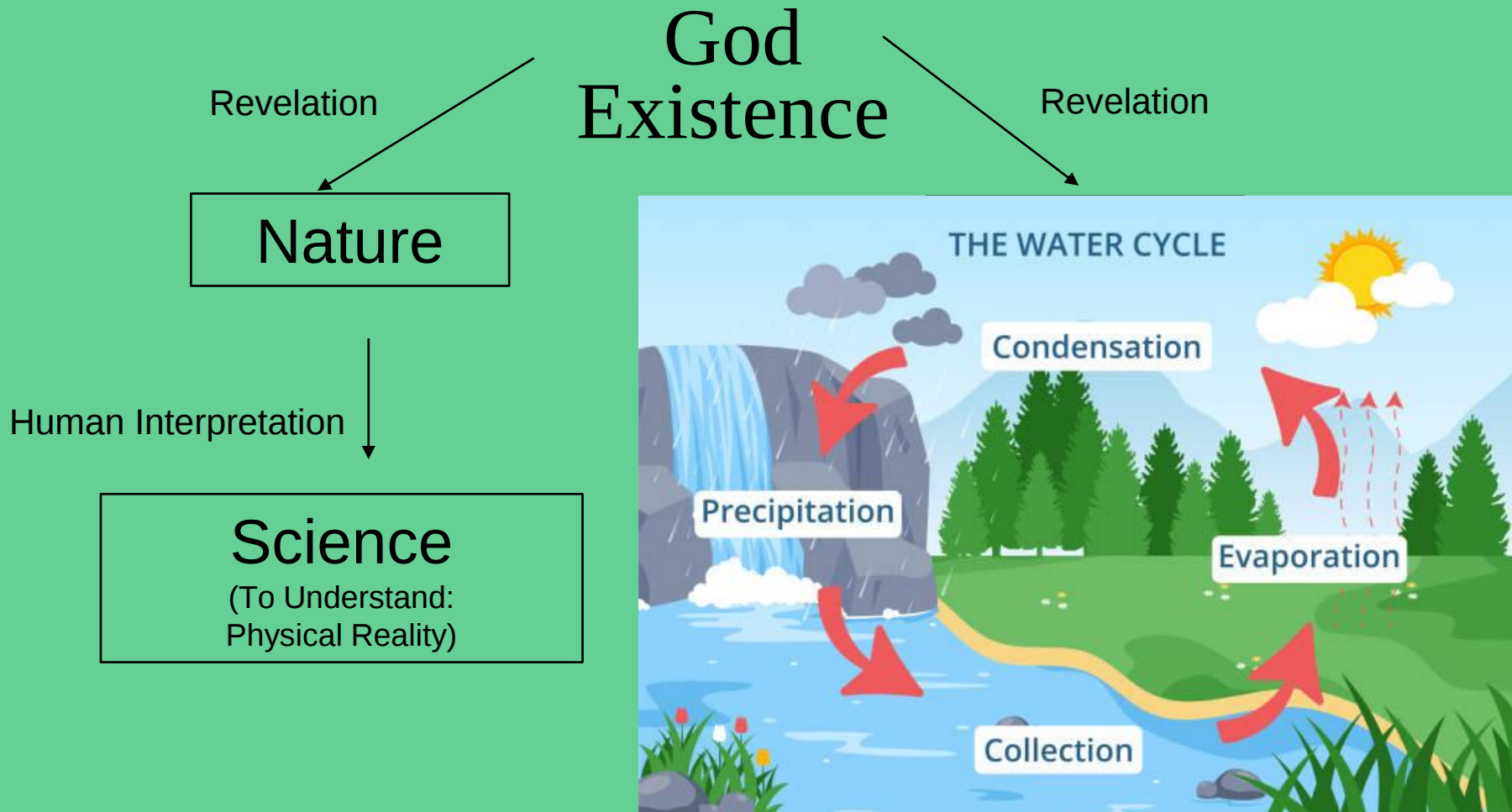

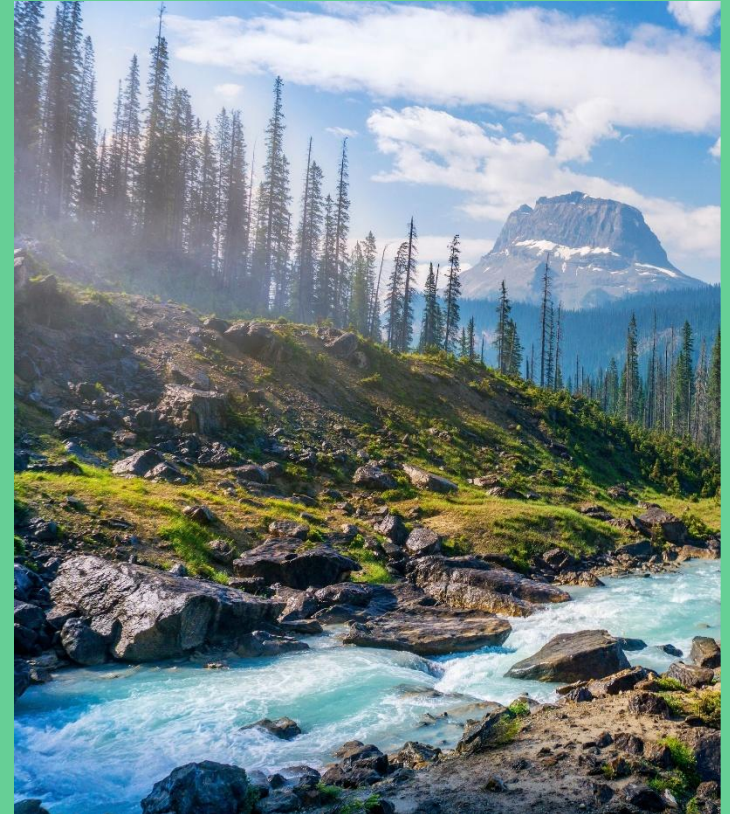

Why Study Nature Theology?

Definition of Apologetics

The practice of explaining and defending the Christian faith with reasons, evidence, and answers to questions or objections.

Think of it like this: If someone asks:

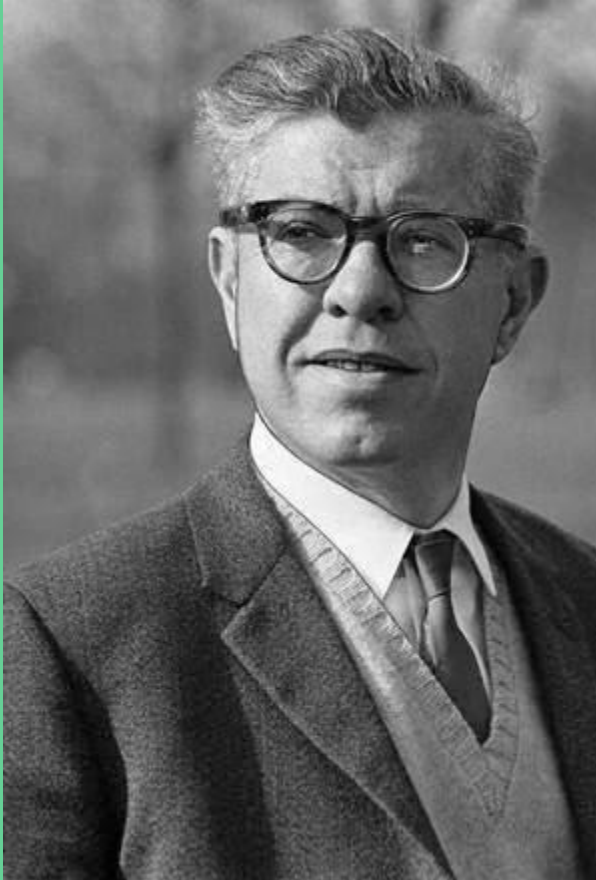
☐ *Why do you believe in God?*

or

☐ *How can the Bible be true?*

or

☐ *How do you know God exists?*

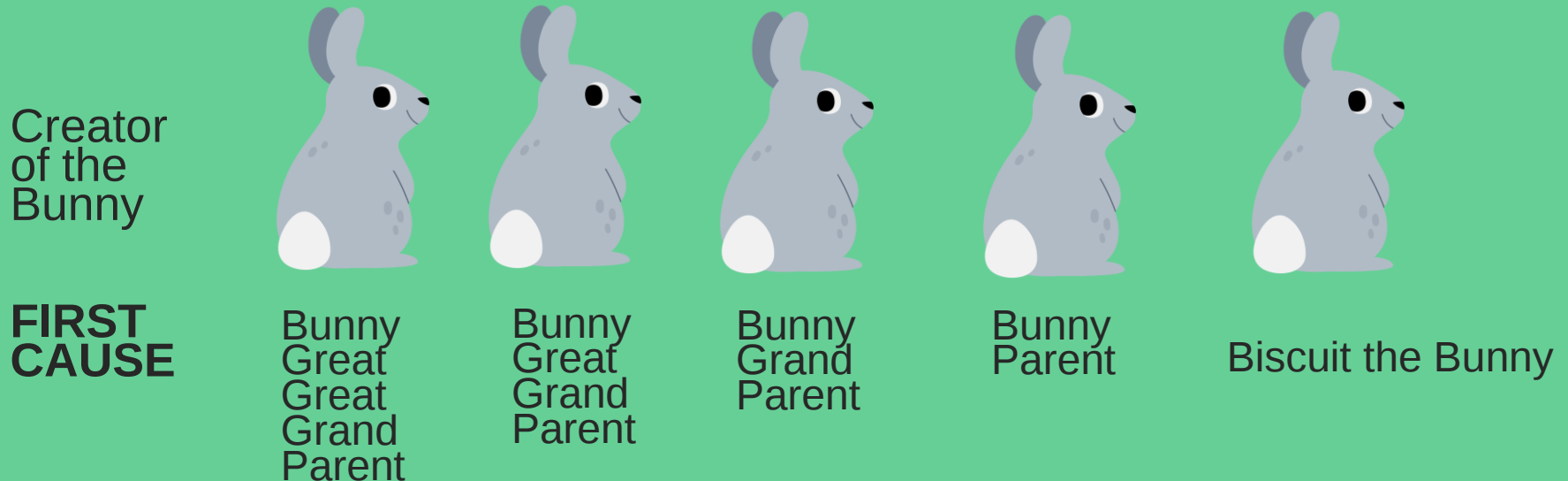

Biscuit the

- Before Biscuit Bunny begins to exist, Biscuit Bunny parents have to begin to exist, and before they begin to exist, their parents have to begin to exist, and so on...
- If everything is like this, nothing would ever begin to exist.
- For every preceding is not existing originally, and has no power to begin to exist by itself.

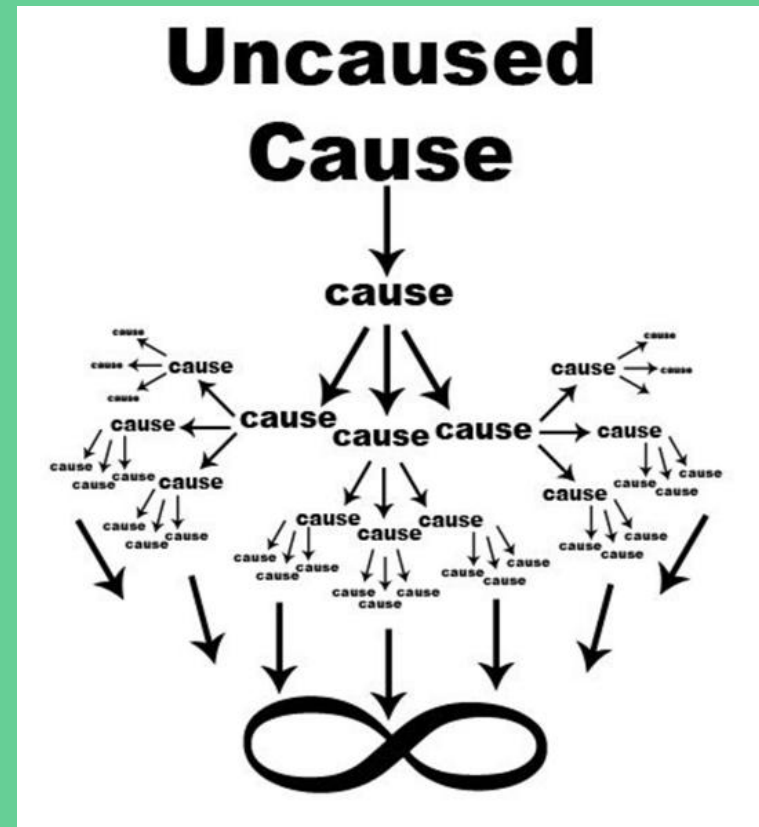
What is required is a **First Cause** which does not need to depend on another thing in order to exist.



(A) Cosmological Argument

Why is the First Cause = God?

- Since the First Cause is the first, it must be uncaused.
- Since whatever begins to exist has a cause, the First Cause must be beginningless.
- The First Cause has the power to bring about the first event by itself.

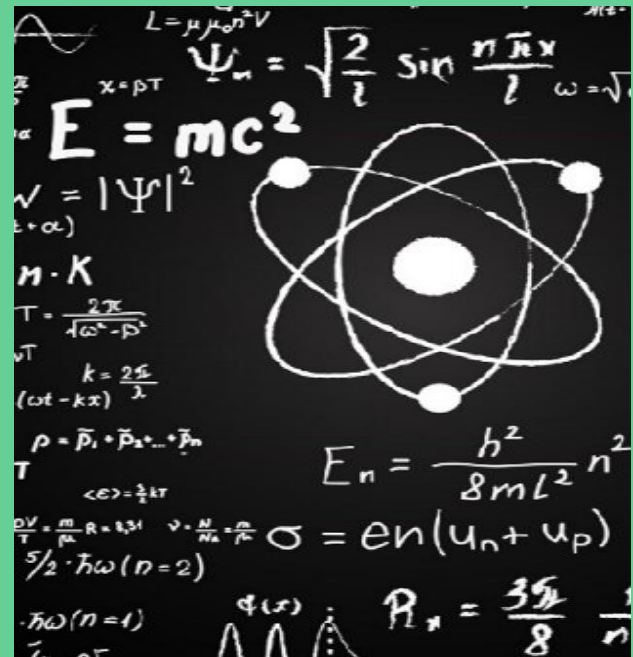


BONUS FACT:

First Cause eliminates other religions
without a First Cause.

(B) Teleological Argument

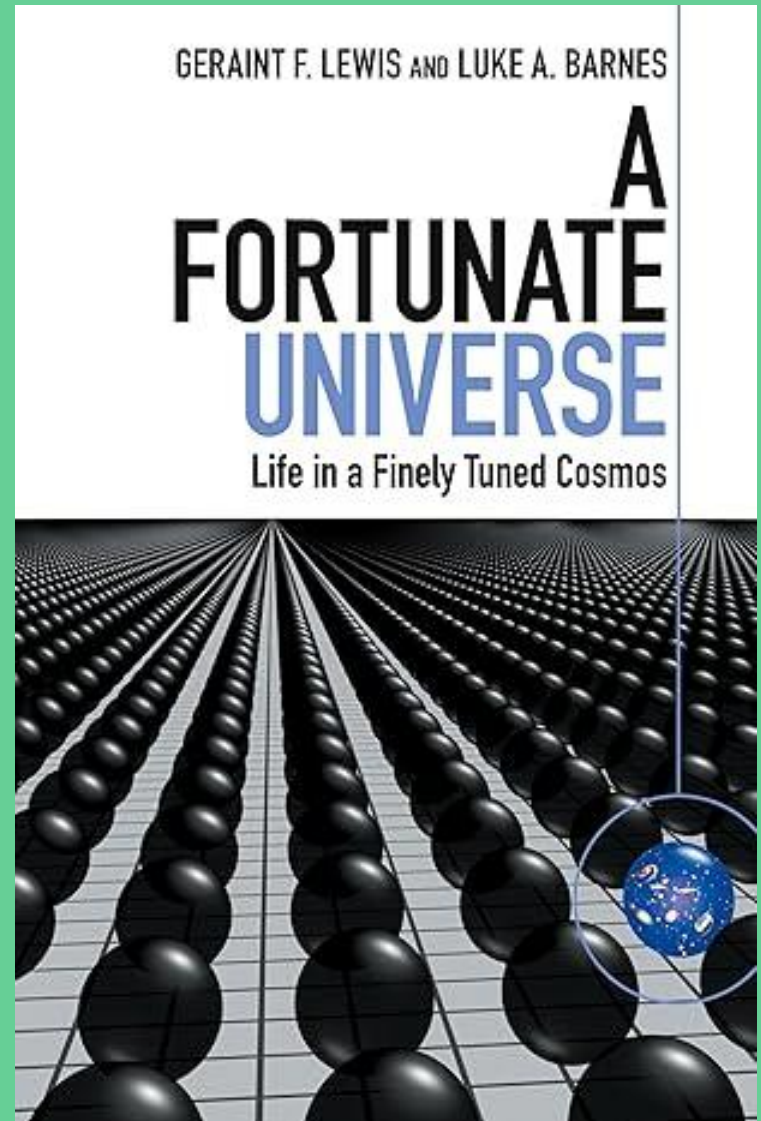
In order to bring about a universe with its highly ordered laws of nature and fine-tuning, the First Cause must be highly intelligent (a 'superior Mind'— Einstein) and enormously powerful.



(B) Teleological Argument

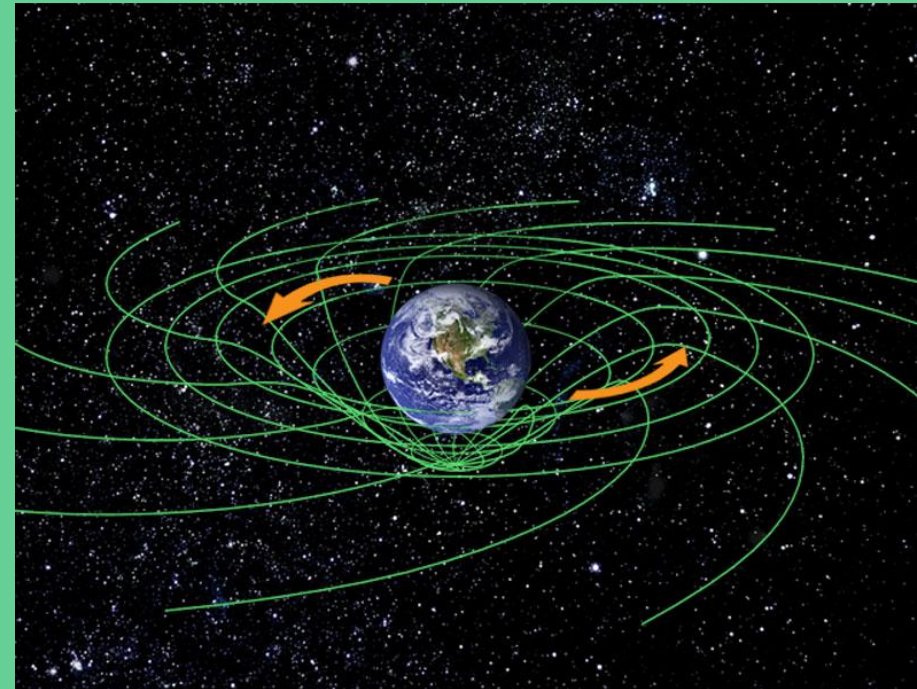
Design of creation:

- (i) Designed by a Super intellect being
- (ii) Designs are High Quality and High Precision



Evidence of Design 1: Earth's Gravity-electromagnetic ratio

Evidence of Design 2: Controlled Explosion that Created the Universe

- Entropy must be extremely highly precise with a very high amount of usable energy.
- Probability that a universe chosen at random would possess the necessary degree of order is 1 in $10^{10^{123}}$.



Probability of Winning TOTO 1st Prize

- TOTO is to pick 6 numbers out of 49
- Odds of winning once:
1 in 13,983,816
(1 in 13.98 million)



Probability Comparison: Odds of Happening in Nature

- Gravity-electromagnetic ratio: 1 in 10^{40} : **Winning 6 times 1st Prize in a continuous row.**
- Entropy: 1 in $10^{10(123)}$: **winning 1.4×10^{122} times 1st Prize in a continuous row.**

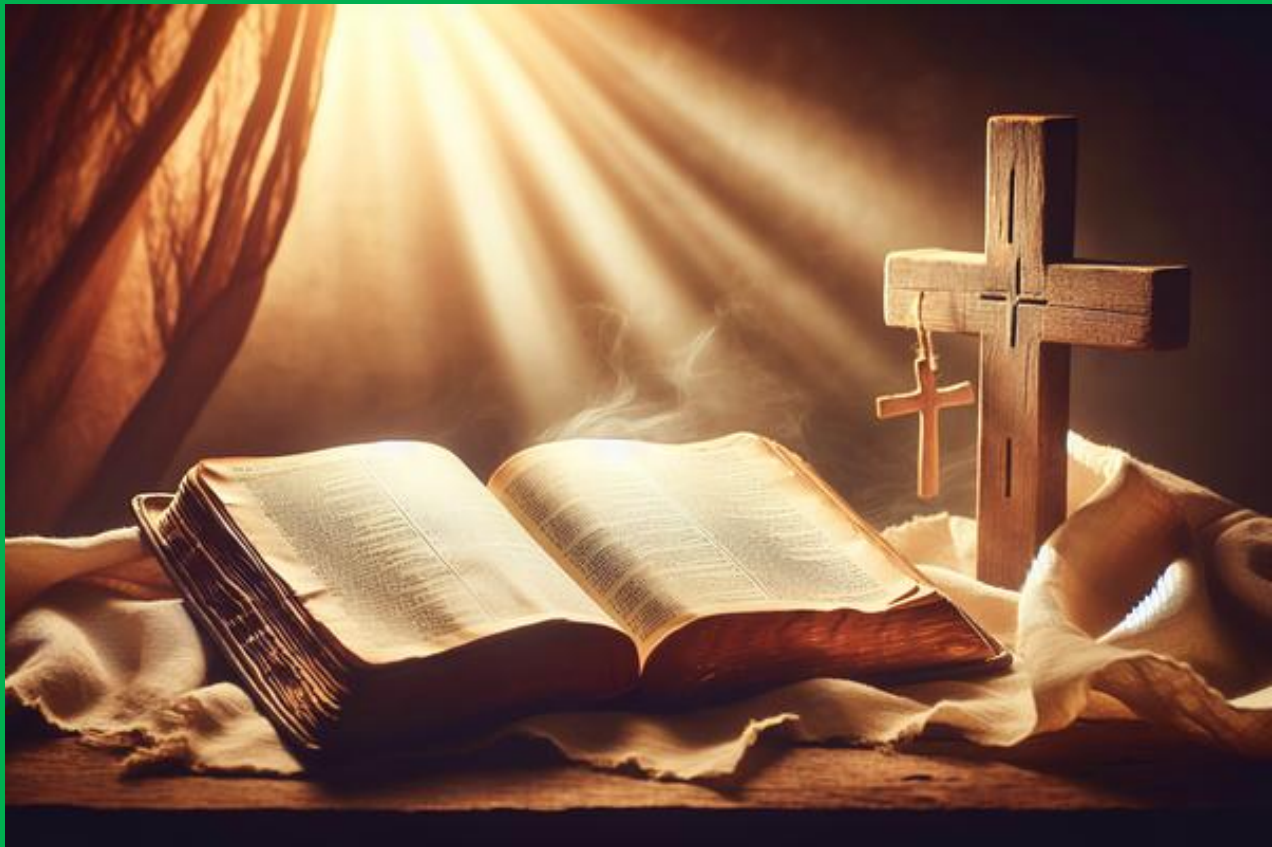
God above gods of Egypt

The Plagues of Egypt

Exodus 7-12

- **Blood** (7:14-24)
The Nile and other waters in Egypt turned to blood.
- **Frogs** (8:1-15)
Frogs cover the land of Egypt.
- **Gnats** (8:16-19)
The dust in the land of Egypt turned to gnats covering all the people and animals.
- **Flies** (8:20-32)
Flies filled the houses and all the land of Egypt.
- **Livestock** (9:1-7)
All the Egyptian livestock die.
- **Boils** (9:8-12)
Boils break out on everyone in Egypt.
- **Hail** (9:13-35)
Hail strikes down everything in the fields - humans, animals, plants and trees.
- **Locusts** (10:1-20)
Locusts cover Egypt destroying everything the hail did not destroy.
- **Darkness** (10:21-29)
Darkness covers Egypt for 3 days.
- **Death of Firstborn** (11:1-12:33)
The firstborn of all the Egyptian people and cattle die.
