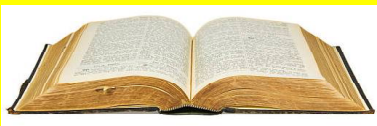

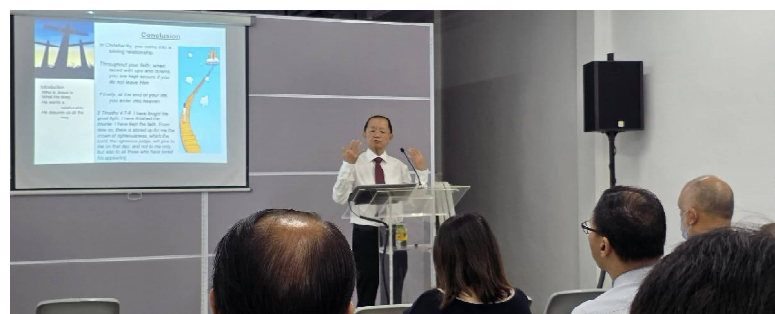
Our Preachers

EPHESIANS 2:8–9

“For by grace you have been saved through faith.
And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of
God, not a result of works.”





Human Grace

1. Conditional
2. Transactional
3. Expectation of Return

God's Grace

1. Unconditional
2. Unmerited Favour
3. Divine Empowerment

Why is it Important?

~ How does it connect in the Bible?

TITUS 2:11 —

“For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people.”

ROMANS 5:20 —

“Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more.”

Why is it Important?

~ *Why is it IMPORTANT in the Bible?*

- Without grace, the law condemns us (Romans 6:14). Grace is the basis of justification.

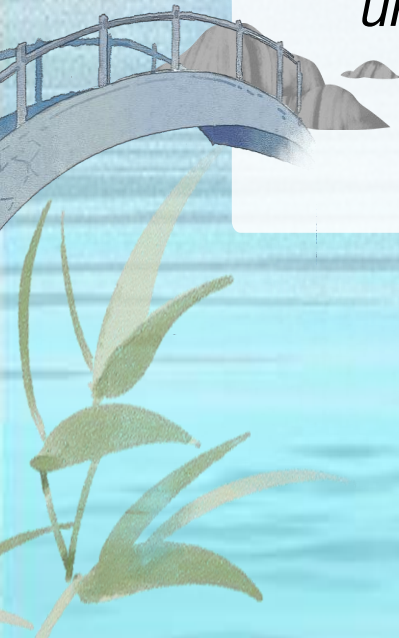
~ *How does it make sense in reality?*

- Grace = second chances → societies built on forgiveness and rehabilitation thrive more than those built purely on punishment.

Why is it Important?

~ How does it not make sense too?

- Human logic resists grace:
- For instance, Jonah resented God's grace to Nineveh (Jonah 4:2). Grace feels unjust because it **even** favours the *undeserving*.





Examples

JONAH 1:17 —

Now the Lord provided a huge fish to swallow Jonah, and Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

JONAH 3:1 —

Then the word of the Lord came to Jonah a second time:

- God rescues Jonah with a fish, then gives him the same commission again: grace as rescue and recommission.

Examples

EXODUS 8:32 —

“ But Pharaoh hardened his heart this time also, and did not let the people go.”

EXODUS 14:4 —

“ And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and he will pursue them, and I will get glory over Pharaoh and all his host, and the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord.” And they did so.

- Pharaoh in Exodus → was already unforgiving and unyielding before God hardened his heart
- God’s patience in sending plague after plague shows extended grace before judgment.



Examples

LAMENTATIONS 3:22–23 —

“The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning.”

Our life itself is evidence of grace.

- Look at our ourselves...
- Despite our countless mistakes, we are alive and well... There must be a reason for this....

Why does God want us here?

- Find that reason...





Jesus

~ the Ultimate expression of Grace...

ROMANS 3:23–24 —

“All have sinned... and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.”

So what now?

~ After learning / re-learning about Grace...

- *What do we do with this knowledge (practical & realistic knowledge)?*

□ *For ourselves & For Others...*

COLOSSIANS 3:13 — “Bear with each other and forgive one another... forgive as the Lord forgave you.”

TRANSFORM: Accept God’s grace → stop carrying guilt.

EXTEND: Show grace to others → patience, forgiveness, generosity.
