Most RPGs these days allow you to dress up your characters in a variety of outfits and clothes, and NieR: Automata allows you to do that as well, to a small extent. To be clear, Automata certainly doesn't have a super wide range of outfits that you can choose from and change into how and when you want. Instead, during the first half of the game, you will basically collect accessories from completing a side mission. For example, you'll unlock a variety of colored tapes from performing the Lost Girl side of the mission, and you can equip the accessory by heading into the items menu and selecting it from the key items. You will unlock combat suit armor for the 2B and 9S at the beginning of the third passing game, and they can also be equipped through the Key Elements tab in your menu. At this point, these are the only alternative outfits that you can unlock for your characters, and there are no other options other than this and the default clothes. It's worth noting that the combat suit doesn't provide any additional perks or stats boosts either, so the clothing changes are purely cosmetic. Most of these costumes have requirements such as completing the game a certain number of times, while others are tied to either side of quests or downloadable content. Additional outfits can be equipped from the Key Elements section of your inventory. Here's a list of additional costumes you can get in NieR: Automata, as well as requirements to unlock each one. Currently, there are very few known alternative outfits that can be obtained in the game. If you find more new outfits in the game, feel free to add them to the list below! If you pre-order Nier Automata, you get access to two exclusive Pod skins that can be equipped with your key elements. Play System Pod - Makes your pod have skin that looks like the first PlayStation console. Grimmuar Weiss - Makes you Pod have alternative skin. Below are accessories and costumes that you can equip for your characters after receiving them from quests or fulfilling certain requirements. After completing the third passage, you can Two combat suits for 2B. The combat suit doesn't offer any stat momentum or change, but it looks slightly different from your default suit. You can equip outfits from your key elements. There are two different combat suits, outfits similar to YoRHa soldier outfits outfits You can see by exploring the location of the bunker. Pink bow and blue bow is a small item that you can equip after completing the Lost Girl side quest. In order to do this, however, you must have already visited Pascal Robot Village and spoke to the robot's mother in the village. It is located on the lower level of the village down the stairs. The lost robot girl is in the desert in the north. Once you find it, you will need to escort it to the end of the desert to the south. Along the way, small groups of enemies will attack, but can be sent easily if you are of a higher level or have a strong weapon. Once you get to the end, the robot girl will leave after giving you a pink bow and blue bow as a reward. You can equip any bow from the menu items in the key elements section for any character you play as long as you've got it in any passing. There is a dress module that you can purchase at Emil's store. Having a module equipped will prevent your character's clothes from stalling when they take damage. In order to get the dress module however, you need to encounter Emil near the Resistance camp. Running this can sometimes be difficult, as Emil is constantly changing his location. However, you can restart and re-enter areas to get it moving around. Once Emil is within the area and you make it stop the movement, you will be able to purchase a dress module for 10,000. Once unlocked, the dress module can be fitted for any character. Moon's Tear is the reward you get from completing Emile's Memories quest. In order to unlock the quest, you need to meet with Emile at least once and complete the Forest Kingdom area. After that, go to the Ruins of the city near the Resistance camp and look for Emil. When you stop him from moving around and talking to him. This will cause a shiny flower to appear in a commercial facility near the forest area (in a shopping mall-like building). When you find the flower, Emil will appear and have a short call with you. This begins Emil Memories quest where you will need to find all the moon flowers for Emile to evoke his lost memories. The location of the flowers will be marked on your map that are located in: Flooded CityAmusement ParkDesert AreaForest Area Flower Search triggers a small conversation with Emile where he will stay to think after talking to him. After that, you can move on to the next place to find other flowers. When you finally find each flower, Emil will give you the key to the elevator in a commercial facility after discovering the latter. Return to a commercial facility near the Forest Area and take the elevator. When you speak to Emil for the last time, he will reward you with a moon flower that you can wear. A flower can Equipped for any character once you unlock it. You can find and equip Emile's mask when you visit visit house for the first time. The second time you visit his house, you can find Emil's head inside his chest. You can get Adam's points on top of the building where you first enter the ruins of the city at the beginning of the game. You can get points after defeating Adam and Eve.
