Double Glazing update - Letters of Support urgently needed please

This long running project has reached the fund-raising stage and we have made bids to several sources. Funders ask for 'letters of support' from the congregation and users of the hall, so can you write or email to support the project?

As a reminder, the Eco group's survey showed that much of the heat loss in the Main Hall is through the windows; we found a supplier of double glazing where the panels are cut to follow the shape of the stonework around each window. The PCC are fully supportive, and we have permission from the Diocese.

If you can email or write a letter, here are the salient points to include. The new glazing will radically impact the energy efficiency of our much loved and used community space and reduce noise from outside the building. It will also ensure that by cutting the double-glazed panels to the shape of these historic windows, their aesthetics will not be compromised.
