The world-touring Filomena Campus Quartet present highly creative jazz sets of "beautifully stylish original songs" - as described by JazzUK. Award winning vocalist and lyricist Filomena Campus fuses jazz with theatre, literature and poetry, drawing inspiration from a variety of influences such as the Commedia dell'Arte, Theatre of the Absurd and her native Sardinia. With her warm stage presence and fearless improvisations, she knows how to bring out the sun.

Campus leads the quartet featuring Steve Lodder on piano, Dudley Phillips on double bass and Rod Youngs on drums and they perform regularly at London venues such as the PizzaExpress Jazz Club, Ronnie Scott's and the Vortex. Ever since the group was formed in 2010, the guartet has toured internationally, with recent performances in Jordan, Marocco, Qatar, Thailand and Italy.

Following their acclaimed album Jester of Jazz, the Filomena Campus Quartet now present their new project, Queen Mab, to be recorded soon. New lyrics by Campus based on Shakespeare, Dario Fo, Franca Rame and Sardinian literature, are set to original music and arrangements by her long-term collaborators Steve Lodder and Dudley Phillips.
