OBL Student Services hires teachers from all over the country. Teachers with OBL Student Services do not have to live in a specific state, but must be certified in certain states based on job postings. Do teachers work all year round? Connections Academy teachers are working a 10-month work schedule. The first and last teacher's working day varies from school to school. Typically, schools follow a similar calendar to local school districts. Teachers work 195 days of service. OBL Student Services teachers and speech pathologists (SLP) work a 10-month work plan. Teachers and SLPs start in early August and end in mid-June. Teachers and SLPs work 195 days of service. Teachers have the opportunity to work over the summer, that is, support for their own school or teaching in summer school courses. Are there part-time opportunities for teachers?
