



# Getaway Vacations – Alaska - Yukon

## June 14 – July 03, 2020 – 20 days

### June 14 Southern/Central Alberta to Edmonton

Boarding our luxury motor coach, we begin our journey to Canada's Yukon and Alaska.

### June 15 Dawson Creek

Travelling in to "big Game Country, we continue to Dawson Creek to view **Milepost "0" of the Alaska Highway**.

### June 16 Muncho Lake

We begin our trek on the Alaska Highway travelling to **Muncho Lake**. Our lodging is situated on the shores of this beautiful mountain lake.

### June 17-18 Whitehorse (2 nights)

We stop at **Liard Hot Springs** before continuing to Whitehorse. We visit **Miles Canyon**, the **SS Klondike** and enjoy free time to choose from several area attractions.

### June 19-20 Dawson City (2 nights)

We continue along the banks of the Yukon River and enjoy an **included picnic**. We **tour the "gold rush" city** visiting a **gold dredge** and the **gold fields**. Browse through the shops or visit the many historic sites on a free afternoon. Be sure to not miss Diamond Tooth Gerties, the historic gaming and entertainment hall.

### June 21-22 Fairbanks (2 nights)

Welcome to Alaska and the **"Top of the World" highway**. The **Alaska Pipeline** and **"Santa Claus House"** are points of interest. In Fairbanks, we cruise aboard the **"Riverboat Discovery"** and enjoy a mouth-watering **"Salmon Bake"** at Alaskaland. Enjoy the "Land of the Midnight Sun" on this, the **longest day of the year**.

### June 23-25 Anchorage (3 nights)

View spectacular scenery as we travel the George Parks Highway. We hope to see North America's tallest peak - **Mt. McKinley** towering 20,320 feet. We travel to Seward for a **cruise on the Kenai Fjords**. Wildlife and glaciers are guaranteed while sailing on a modern tour vessel to spot Humpback Whales, Orcas, and the glaciers dotting the coastline. We tour throughout the city with free time planned to explore the shops, services and galleries of downtown.

### June 26 Tok

This morning we travel in to the Matanuska Valley and stop at the **Musk Ox Farm**. Learn about these prehistoric ice age survivors and their unique role in Native Alaskan culture. We continue to Tok for the evening.

### June 27 Haines

We travel along Kluane Lake, the St. Elias Mountains and **Kluane National Park**. From Haines Junction we travel south to the coast through an "alps-like" terrain to Haines for the night.

### June 28 Skagway

**Sailing through the inside passage** we arrive at **Skagway** where gold miners began their trek to the Klondike. Spend the afternoon exploring the shops and historic sites.

### June 29 Watson Lake

The **White Pass & Yukon Railway** brings history alive with colourful narration of gold rush tales and incomparable scenery. We continue to Watson Lake for overnight and take time to view the famed **Sign Post Forest**.

### June 30 Stewart/Hyder

The **Cassiar Highway** takes us back to British Columbia. The spectacular drive to Stewart is lined with incredible glaciers and waterfalls.

### July 01 Prince George

Joining the Yellowhead Highway we continue to Prince George.

### July 02 Sunwapta (Jasper)

**Mt. Robson** - dominates our drive to Jasper. Carved to depths of 55 meters, **Maligne Canyon** affords breathtaking views. The wilderness setting of Sunwapta is our host for **tonight's farewell dinner**.

### July 03 Southern/Central Alberta

Travelling the **Icefields Parkway** we stop to view the landlocked Athabasca Glacier before continuing our journey home.
