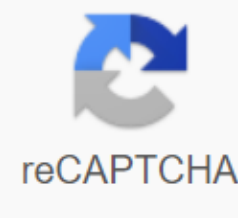

## Botw south lomei labyrinth guide

How to find the center of three puzzles of the Lomey Maze in the Breath of Wildlife. The mazes of zelda are some of the most unique shrines in the game, with huge mazes that you have to navigate to get more precious spirit balls. While the Northern Maze of Lomey, the South Lomei Maze and the Loemi Maze Island can be solved by exploring naturally, there are shortcuts for all three if you want to just finish them and move on. While we have direct solutions below, it's worth exploring them to the fullest if you can mine them. While there is nothing as unique as the above, it is a good source of weapons, rupees and other items. If you're exploring though you can follow the rule when tackling mazes in general - keep turning in one direction and you'll get there in the end - the mazes of zelda work a little differently, with some routes hidden in the middle of certain sections, or hidden under strips that the map doesn't show. It is located in the far north of the map, almost in the center, on the outer right edge of the snowy region of Gebra - expect to equip a cold steady item or two to get there. Go to the Maze through the front walkway and climb to the top. Make your way past the center (there is a diamond chest in the central niche) and make your way to the block, which is a different color facing west on the east side. The exact position here: You'll know that you're in the right place, as if you look down, you'll see a collection of electric Chuchus on one side and a set of torches on the other. Lower the torches side and then head up the stairs on this wall. It is located in the southwest corner of the map, on the right side of the desert region of the Wasteland. Like others, it's pretty visible from the map as soon as you unlock the nearby tower. Get on top of the maze - either climbing up or sliding down from the surrounding mountains - and position yourself east of the center, as shown here: You know you're in the right place where, if you look down, you can see two segments of the black gannon snum on different levels. If you fall down to a side that is not covered, you will find a corridor at the bottom on the segments of the soy, with a hole on the right. Go here, and the sanctuary of Dila Maag will be just around the corner. Buy The Legend of zelda: Breath of the Wild from the Amazon? FlagView HistoryNae's Desert Maze quest is one of 42 Shrine quests in the legend of zelda: Breath of the Wild. The successful completion of this sanctuary quest shows the hidden Dila Maag sanctuary in the Herudo Wasteland region. To begin the search for the shrine, enter the southern maze of Lomei in the eastern part of the Gerudo Desert between Mount Granage and the Eastern Barren at the foot of the Daoval Peak. There are several paths you can take to get to the South Lomey Maze. The most common is the land route through an area known as the Champion Gate - located near the East Barren, north of the Cave Tala Temple. You can also take the path along the high mountains down to the southeast of the Wasteland Tower and Spectacle Rock on a paraglider to the maze, but keep in mind that Bokoblin snipers patrol the high walls. See and download the map here at the Enter South Lomei maze from the main entrance to the north (fly down to the entrance if you have taken a mountain route). You should see the steps (sanctuary below them) but don't head straight. Instead, do your immediate right, which will lead you along the outer wall of the maze. Make the left and you still have to be outside the main maze. Keep walking until holes on the left side of the inner maze maze This is the only entrance on this side so you can't miss it. Go up the steps and make the left. As you go down the stairs, on the right there will be a patch of decline. You can climb around it if you want to, but if you don't want to, continue straight until you can make your next straight through the doorway. Turn left and then right to cross the hall and go right to get out of this area onto the long hall with some decay to your left, forcing you to go right rather than end up in the hall on the other side of the first pool of decline. Now you can continue through the exit along the southeast side and turn right. Jump down and enter the doorway to your left. Do the right when you enter the doorway and continue straight until you are forced to do to the left. There will be much of Ganon's essence down the hall. You can climb around, or you can take a safer route, climbing left in front of the blight, and take the entrance to the inner maze. Take the immediate right and then right again to head some steps to the left and go straight up and down the small stairs until you hit the wall - pass straight all the way to another long hall. When you do that left, you should see two light poles at the top of the long steps (you're almost there). Run up the stairs and jump down past the light poles. Continue straight until you reach the end of the corridor, where you can turn left. Make that left, and down the corridor, there's a massive part of The Ganon essence that may be too high for you to climb around (you can't run through this). If so, do the left in the doorway just before the essence. Run up the stairs and jump through the hole in the floor. Do right after the hole and go down the steps. Make your immediate right at the bottom of the steps and continue until you are forced to make left. Do it left and there will be a hole to your right. Head out of the doorway and you have to see the essence of

the barrier you went around to your right, so keep left down the corridor. (If you could climb around it, this is where you continue as well). Make the left side at the end of the corridor and you should see a little more essence in front of you. Ignore it and do the right right before the essence. Make a left when you enter the room and you did it! Enter the sanctuary of Dila Maag and get your free Spirit Orb as well as one of the barbaric armor set pieces from the treasure chest inside the sanctuary. Don't leave yet: There is a valuable treasure in the maze. Check out the interactive maps to find the Golden Rupee (300), the Herudo Shield, the Golden Claymore, the Golden Onion, Cerudo Scimitar and the Silver Rupee (100). The Sanctuary Maze Desert quest is located southeast of the Wasteland Tower. gallery above for the exact location.) In short, look for a rectangular structure that seems uninhabited in the desert. It's the South Lomay Maze, and Through its northern entrance will give you a temple quest.
