To make sure the ink doesn't spill, pull the security tag from the rest of the fabric as much as you can. Step 3. Place a rubber band around the security tag pin. The rubber top should be strong but thin enough to slide under the security switch and go around the pedestal. It'll loosen the pin. Step four. Hold the ink cartridge in one hand, and then pull the pin with the other. Pull it with enough power so the security tag will pop up easily. If it doesn't come off, then add more rubber bands around it. 2. How to remove a security tag from clothes with a screwdriver If you have a screwdriver with a thin edge at home, you can use it to remove a badge from the clothes! Here's how to do it step by step: Step 1. Place your clothes on a flat surface with the ink cartridge facing inward upwards. Phase two. The ink cartridge is the part of the switch that is expressed from the plastic. It's on the other side of the pin, which is the round part of the badge. 2 Pull the part of the clothes with the badge away from the rest of the clothes. Move it as far as possible so that ink doesn't destroy the clothes so much if the sensor breaks. 3 Slide a rubber band around the pin of the security tag. The rubber top should be big and thick enough to be strong, but thin enough to fit around the pin. It'll loosen the pin. 4 Hold the larger part of an ink tag in one hand. 5 Pull the pin with your other hand. The pressure of the pins should be strong enough so that the pin eventually jumps or easily pulls separately from the rest of the tag. If the rubber band hasn't released it enough, try again with multiple rubber bands. 1 Place the item of clothing on the floor with the ink cartridge facing inward. 2 Take a very thin flat screwdriver and place it along the edge of the raised square pyramid. 3 Strong pressure. It's supposed to puncture the plastic and pull it up. 4 Continue to pop the perimeter of the plastic. 5 Remove the foil lining. You can see the metal plate underneath. 6 Use a screwdriver to lift one of the metal arms holding the pin in place. 7 Slide the pin from the switch. The pin should easily slide through the hole without now and the badge must be removed. 1 Freeze the garment with an ink tag. Freeze the garment overnight for best results. 2 Rip 2. You can just use your hands, a heartburn, or a rubber band method. This will ensure that ink is not spilled if you make a mistake - ink can't spill if it's frozen. 1 Gently pull the badge from the clothes several times. Do it about 10 times, until it loosens the pin a little bit. 2 Find a big nail. The nail should be larger than the brand, and the nail head should be at least as wide as a penny. 3 Pull the badge out of the clothes. Hold the long plastic part of the tag aside. 4 Hit the ink cartridge until it opens. Without applying too much force, repeatedly hit the ink cartridge until it opens. You may have to hit it twenty times or more to get it right. Be careful not to hit it too hard, or the tag will be more likely to explode open. 1 Hold the security tag with the side of the ink cartridge up. 2 Hold on either side of the rectangular tag with pering. 3 Gripped the other side of the badge with a pair of different peries. 4 Gently bend each side of the tag down using pering. Don't bend too hard or the switch will crack in half and shed ink everywhere. 5 Continue bending until it jumps open. It's supposed to loosen the pin and cause it to explode. Many modern tags actually contain an electromagnet, not an ink case; After you open it, you'll see for yourself that there's no ink in it. 1 Put something between the badge and the top of the pin to give it some slack. 2 Bend the pin back and forth until it breaks. 3 Pull the tag straight back so that the pin comes out and this hole originally passed. 4 break open the badge. 1 burn the badge. Using a lighter, burn the dome like part of the switch. After burning it for a few seconds it will, apparently, catch fire like its plastic. 2 Use a knife or similar object to chop the dome. 3 As you continue to rake in, you will find a tag spring will pretty much pop out. Most of the garment's security tags have one or more pins inside that secure the cartridge to the body of the badge. You may be able to cut the wire if you can manage a wire cutter between 2 halves of the tag, but these pins are thick and may be difficult to cut. Another option is to use the Dermal tool, but also could be damage to your garment. Question: Do these badges turn off the alarms at the door? Often, yes, they're designed to raise alarm, but that's not the case in every store. Question about what kind of clothing should these methods be used for? Ink is usually black or a blue ink pen, so really it should be used on dark clothing. Whether it's light or white, take the time to go to the store and have it removed there. Question: Does the magnet method work on ink tags? If an ink tag requires a magnet to open it at checkout, it should work. Question: How do I remove the badge still in the store? You don't know. Buy it and the nice people at the counter will do it at no extra charge. Question: If I'm trying to remove the security badge with my hands, is there any chance that the fabric will tear at this point? There's a chance unless you're very careful.
