

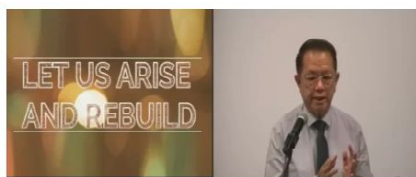

Isaiah 44:13-17 *The carpenter... plants a fir tree, and the rain nourishes it. Then shall it be for a man to burn; and he takes of it, and warms himself; yes, he kindles it, and bakes bread: yes, he makes a god, and worships it; he makes it an engraved image, and falls down to it.*

He burns part of it in the fire; with part of it he eats flesh; he roasts meat, and is satisfied; yes, he warms himself, and says, Aha, I am warm, I have seen the fire. The residue of it he makes a god, even his engraved image; he falls down to it and worships, and prays to it, and says, Deliver me; for you are my god.

Happy Father's Day

My observation is that fathers are not seen as doing as good a job as mothers. It is a dedicated balance being a husband, father and breadwinner. Although we can name many good mothers amongst our acquaintances, we struggle to name good fathers.

The Bible records good men of God who failed miserably as fathers. King David and the high priest Eli tops the list of bad fathers.

Important Role

While mothers are needed to keep the household running, fathers fulfil an important role in setting the example, maintaining discipline and setting the direction for the family.

Too often, the father is absent or neglects his duty so the mother has to come in and stand in the gap. In the case of single parent families, many children grow up without a father figure in the home, as the mother often is awarded custody of the children.

God-given Responsibility

Fathers cannot assume their place as the head of the house without earning it. It is not just occupying the head of the table but setting the family in order and working with the entire family to ensure the priorities are in the right order.

This takes work, planning and effort. Most of all, it requires spending time with the family, being there on occasions and taking time to celebrate birthdays, baptisms and church together.

Family Devotional

One area that is sadly lacking among fathers in Singapore is leading in regular family devotionals. This is such an important and key role for fathers to lead. I daresay that the father who has succeeded in doing this on a regular basis, will find the rest of his duties falling in place.

Better felt than Taught

Children will not remember everything you say but little pitchers have long ears. They will catch how you talk up or criticize the church and quickly sum up how your talk matches your walk.


Father's Day 2021

Today is international Father's Day 2021. How will today be different from the Father's Day in the past? Here are some suggestions.

1. Do not wait for a pat on the head. (Do you really think you deserve it?) Instead take the initiative to thank members of your family for their support, grace and forgiveness for your shortcomings.
2. Treat your family by doing something meaningful together.
3. Do better for the next 12 months.

Used widely for both religious and secular purposes – even sung by the crowds at sports matches


Written as a Christian hymn in 1779 by John Newton

He grew up without any particular religious conviction - became involved in the slave trade

In 1748, a violent storm battered his vessel off the coast of Ireland so severely that he called out to God for mercy. This moment marked his conversion

1764, Newton entered full-time ministry

Amazing Grace was written to illustrate a sermon on New Year's Day of 1773

When we were approaching 2021, many were optimistic about the future. Some even predicted that things would return to normal! Now that half of the year is almost over, people are thinking that 2021 may be even worse than 2020.

As Christians, whatever the world throws at us, we stand on our faith and are assured of the same love, protection and direction, pandemic or not.

How About HoF?

After a year and half of the pandemic, the Lord has taken good care of the Household of Faith.

We were able to live stream without interruption and even created a mobile-friendly website to link to these video sermons.

Recently, we were able to conduct in-person worship at the Launchpad and managed to encourage most members to return to worship.

What's Ahead?

Right round the corner is our 4th Anniversary on 16th July. It is unlikely that restrictions will be relaxed enough for any celebration, but it will be a good time for the Household of Faith to rebuild and renew and for all of us to rededicate.

One of the things that we have seriously looked at is to register the church. I have visited with our lawyer, brother Dennis Loh who is willing to help us on this quest, pro bono. In order to do this, members have to be willing to step forward

to serve in the committee. Our numbers are small, especially when we can only use male members who are regular every Sunday.

Please let me know your thoughts and willingness to serve as committee members. Brother Dennis told me that the process may take up to 6 months, but we just need a 3-5 men to serve. As our contributions is less than a million dollars, the procedure is quite simple.

Immediate Need

Our first challenge is to find a meeting place for us to come together by September. The Lord has shown us Launchpad, we are looking at hotels owned by Far East Organisation, a Christian company and other options.

Just as the Lord has provided our every need, we are also relying on Him in this matter. He will take better care of us, much more than any scheme that we can come up with.

I leave you with the promise of God in Ephesians 3:20-21 *Now to him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to him be the glory in the assembly and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.*






