I've used it on a number of projects before and it always felt like it was missing a lot of features that regular web application frameworks do out of the box. If you want this functionality, or anything close to it, you're best off rolling your own project.

Factors influencing postoperative pulmonary function and rehabilitation in patients undergoing the Fontan operation. Factors that influence postoperative pulmonary function and rehabilitation were studied in 19 patients (age range 2-18 years) who had undergone the Fontan operation and in their parents. All patients were classified into five groups according to the postoperative pulmonary function and rehabilitation. A total of 6 patients had no problem with postoperative pulmonary function or rehabilitation. Twelve patients had a mild degree of problems, and one patient had moderate or severe problems with pulmonary function or rehabilitation. Results of multivariate regression analysis showed that the postoperative pulmonary function and rehabilitation are influenced by the following factors: pulmonary artery pressure, preoperative pulmonary artery oxygen saturation, postoperative pulmonary function, operation time, preoperative left atrial and right atrial pressure, postoperative pulse oxygen saturation, and ejection fraction.
