As the name suggests, Windows 7 SP1 also has a highly compressed edition for home users only. It has some of the same features of the full version, but it is restricted to the home edition of Windows 7. The consumer version of Windows 7 SP1, Windows 7 Enterprise, also comes with four editions, though they are only available in the S, E and K editions. The M edition, however, is only released in volume licensing for those who already have the fully functional M edition. Windows 7 SP1 was released on July 1, 2009. Windows 7 SP2 Windows 7 SP2 (Windows Server 2008 R2) adds three additional versions: The S, E and K editions are restricted to the standard, enterprise and professional versions of Windows Server 2008 R2, respectively. The M edition is only available through volume licensing for Windows Server 2008 R2. Windows 7 SP2 was released on July 7, 2009. Windows 7 SP3 Windows 7 SP3 was released on August 1, 2009. Windows 7 SP3 Release 2 was released on October 15, 2010.
