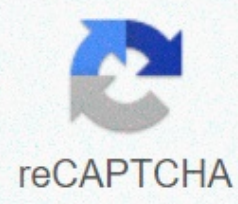

Plus, all your tasks and changes are synced to your Wunderlist account on the web so you don't need to sync or push your changes to another device. In addition, you can share links with other users and collaborate on projects. If you're already using another web service and want an app that will sync with your Android phone, Astrid is a great alternative. If you're willing to invest money, Astrid has a location awareness plugin that will set you back \$1.49 and a Power Pack for \$3.99 that includes features like home screen widgets and voice support. Combined with Todo.txt Command Line Interface (CLI) for Windows and you have a sleek but powerful way to manage your to-dos in progress or on your computer. Another utility, Epistle (Free), works in a similar way. Most other to-do managers for Android are in for free with paid extras or a freemium department. ReQall (Free), has a great Android app that syncs with ReQall webapp, but sync is often a buggy and its best features, such as integration with Evernote and Google Calendar, SMS reminders and location awareness are only available to ReQall Pro subscribers from \$19.99 per year. GTasks (Free) is an easy-to-use to-do manager that syncs with and is ideal for people who use Google tasks. The ad is supported and will cost you \$6.99 to remove.
