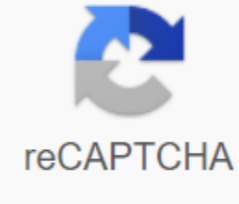

## Bibles for the blind

Whether you live in a city apartment, a house in the suburbs, or a cabin in the woods, a little privacy is always good. The easiest way to keep prying eyes, or, you know, is just light in general- from your home through window treatments like blinds. Blinds consist of separate, thin plastic, wooden or metal bands that can be easily adjusted, said Lee Creech, vice president of merchandising at Lowe's. Wooden blinds are favored because of their warm appearance, although they can be difficult to maintain in rooms that have a lot of moisture, like bathrooms, or humid climates. Although they work with windows of any size, they are especially ideal for large windows, as wooden slats weigh less than their artificial wooden counterparts. Wooden blinds are usually more expensive than synthetic or metal blinds, and they are also slightly above maintenance- you can't use harsh chemicals to clean them; otherwise, the wood may be damaged.
