Six levels of heat are available. Tap up or down and switch between levels If there is only one bar, the fireplace will turn off if you hold down the arrows. Keep in mind, the smart mode doesn't allow the heat settings there are six fan speeds to adjust them, keep the key mode until the fan icon is available, and use up/down arrows to adjust the fan speed. To turn on the accent lights, tap the mode icon until the aux icon is available. Tap up the arrow to turn the light on and down the arrow to turn it off to dim the light, use the handle that is next to the remote receiver. A feature of your Mendot fireplace is the ability to control secondary burner key mode until the burner icon shows the use of the key up to turn the secondary heat burner out is not dependent on the secondary burner Temperature icon displayed as Fahrenheit and Celsius temperature scales to switch between either, keep both the mode and temperature buttons down until the temperature icon is displayed and then hold again. To prevent children's injuries, simultaneously press the mode and up the controller to block the functions.
