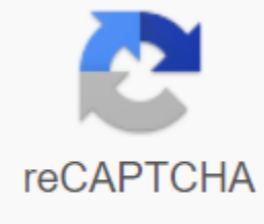

Social psychology baron and branscom

Robert A. Baron is Wellington Professor of Management and Psychology at Rensselaer RPI. He received his doctorate in social psychology from the University of Iowa (1968). Professor Baron has served as a professor at Purdue, the University of Minnesota, Texas, South Carolina, Washington, Princeton University and Oxford University. From 1979 to 1981 he served as Director of the Social Psychology and Development Psychology Program at NSF. In 2001, he was appointed as a visiting senior fellow at the French Ministry of Studies (University of Toulouse). Baron is a member of the APA and a member of the APS Charter. He has published more than a hundred articles and forty chapters, and is the author of 48 books on management and psychology. He holds three U.S. patents and was the founder and CEO of IEP, Inc. (1993-2000). His current research interests focus on social and cognitive factors in entrepreneurship. Ryla R. Branscomb is Professor of Psychology at the University of Kansas. In 1980, she received a bachelor's degree from York University in Toronto, a bachelor's degree from the University of Western Ontario in 1982 and a doctorate from Purdue University in 1986. Professor Branscombe conducted a postdoctoral appointment at the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign in 1987. In 1993, she was a visiting fellow at the Free University of Amsterdam. For three years she has served as Deputy Editor of the Bulletin on Personality and Social Psychology and is now Deputy Editor of Group Processes and Intergroup Relations. Professor Branscombe has published more than a hundred articles and chapters in professional journals and edited volumes. In 1999, she won the Otto Klienberg Prize for Research in Intercultural and International Relations from the Society for Psychological Research on Social Issues. In 2004, she co-edited *Collective Wine: International Perspectives*, published by Cambridge University Press., and the 2007 volume *Brown's Memory: The Social Psychology of Racism and Discrimination*, published by the American Psychological Association. Professor Branscombe's current research focuses primarily on two main issues: the psychology of privileged groups, particularly when and why they may feel guilty for their advantages and harmful actions towards other social groups, and the psychology of disadvantaged groups, especially how they deal with prejudice and discrimination. Donn Byrne holds the rank of Professor Emeritus at the University of Albany, New York State University. In 1958, he received his Ph.D. from Stanford University and held academic positions at San Francisco State University, the University of Texas and Purdue University, as well as Professor at the University of Hawaii and Stanford University. He was elected president of the Midwestern Psychological Association and the Society for Research Research Sexuality. He led the Personality Program in Texas, the Social Personality Program in Purdue and Albany, and the head of the Department of Psychology in Albany. Professor Byrne is a member of the American Psychological Association and a member of the Charter of the American Psychological Society. During his career, Professor Byrne has published more than 150 articles in psychological journals, and twenty-nine of them have been republished in reading books. He is the author or co-author of 37 chapters in edited volumes, and fourteen books, including *Psychology: An Introduction to Behavioral Science*, *An Introduction to Personality, Attraction Paradigm*, and *The Study of Human Sexuality*. He served on the editorial boards of fourteen professional journals and supervised the doctoral work of 52 graduate students. He was invited to give a lecture to G. Stanley Hall at a meeting of the American Psychological Association in Los Angeles in 1981 and at a scientific presentation in 1981 at a meeting of the Society for sexual research in New York. In 1986, he was invited to testify before the Attorney General's Commission on Obscenity and Pornography in Houston, and in 1986 in Arlington, Virginia, attended a seminar by Surgeon General Meop on pornography and health. In 1987, he received the Award for Excellence in Research at the University of Albany, and in 1989 he received the Society for sexuality Research. In 2002, he attended *Festschrift* at the University of Connecticut in honor of his scientific contributions organized by his graduate students (past and present) from Texas, Purdue and Albany. In 2004, he gave a memorial lecture to William Griffith at the University of Kansas. Professor Byrne's current research interests focus on the definition of interpersonal attraction, adult attraction styles and sexual coercion. The main focus of social psychology, 14e, is the social world, which has changed a lot in recent years as part of technological progress. These changes have important implications for how we think about ourselves and others. Social psychology is an industry of psychology that studies all aspects of our behavior with and towards others, our feelings and thoughts about them and the relationships we develop with them. The central message for social psychology as an area and for any book that seeks to represent it is: Keep an eye on these technological changes in terms of their impact on social life, and that is exactly what was done in the 14th edition of this book. Professor Branscombe has published more than 120 articles and chapters, was one of the winners of the Otto Kleinberg Prize for Research in Intercultural and International Relations, as well as the 1996 and 2001 Society for Personality and Social Psychology Publishing Award. She co-edited the 2004 volume *Collective Wine: International Perspectives*, published by Cambridge University Press, the 2007 volume *Brown's Memory: The Social Psychology of Racism and Discrimination*, published by the American Psychological Association, and the 2010 volume *Restoring Social Identity*, published by Psychology Press.
