San Diego's Best Beautiful Beach Gallery Recently a decade has seen downtown San Diego transformed into a highly trafficked entertainment mecca, with a gergasi dance club, low main lounge and see-and-view bar, plus an after-restaurant that serves every conceivable dish, another new park for the city's break-in team, the San Diego Pad. Stunning weather throughout the year makes San Diego one of the best places in the country for outdoor recreation, including surfing on Black's Beach which is a selection of clothing and kayaking around the caves at La Jolla Cove. Fast Facts && Proper Facts & Geography Information and landscapes: Located in the southwest corner of California, San Diego is the largest city in the country, bound loosely by mountain and desert mountains to the east and the border of Mexico to the south. Like Los Angeles, San Diego is a suburb and a widespread area of indecency. Central San Diego is full of hills and valleys, and the city's 70-rock coastal area comprises a vast, flat, sandy area in places like the Pacific Coast and La Jolla Shores to Ocean Beach and Torrey Pines. Mission Bay is inland from the Pacific, alienating the skinny sand trail known as Mission Beach, while the greater San Diego Bay separates downtown from Coronado island (which is actually peninsula). There are also neighboring towns that make up the San Diego metropolitan area, including Chula Vista, El Cajon, La Mesa, Encinitas, Carlsbad, Oceanside, and Escondido, plus dozens of small towns in between. General orientation: The downtown area of San Diego is located beside the San Diego Bay opposite Coronado, with popular beach areas such as La Jolla, the Pacific Coast (or PB) and mission Beaches located a few miles north near the city's smaller Mission Bay. Most of the action takes place in western Interstate 5, an artery that runs north/south through the city and cruises to Interstate 8, which passes through the Mission Valley and connects the coast to suburban areas further east. The uptown neighborhood of San Diego (such as Hillcrest, University Heights, and North Park) is located in an altitude area above the city centre, on the north side of Balboa Park. Security: San Diego is probably the sixth safest large city in the United States, says the city's police officers, but crime is no stranger to these polished streets, well looked after. Vigilance will serve you well when walking alone at night through certain neighborhoods, especially those to the south and east of the city centre, and on the post-dark beaches. The streets can also be treacherous, with heavy traffic and intricate highway systems (added, San Diego is not known for having the world's best drivers). In nightlife areas, such as the Pacific Coast and the Gaslamp Quarter, keep an eye on drunk drivers. Population: San Diego has a population of 1.2 million, making it the second largest city in the state of California. Climate/weather: The average daily temperature hovers around 70 degrees Fahrenheit, and nearly three-quarters of days are bright, which means the weather is generally so mild that you don't think about it. The average winter plunged to about 65 degrees Fahrenheit, so going to the beach wasn't out of the question even at Christmas (although the light jacket might be a good idea). August, meanwhile, has the hottest day, with an average temperature of 78 degrees Fahrenheit. Some things to watch, though, especially if you're planning a late spring/early summer tour: The San Diego coastal area is hit by a phenomenon that the weather calls May Gray and June Gloom, where a thick layer of marine stratus descends on the beach. Coastal clouds may remain all day but sometimes give way to some dangerous afternoon sunshine. Whether you are planning to fly to San Diego International Airport or drive to the city, make sure you have a map to help you get around.
