With the launch of its tablet A500-only second sport Google tablet-focused Honeycomb OS-Acer shows big plans. This sheds its volume for the cost of the missions that served him so well in netbook games, and aimed at quality. Acer unveiled its A500 Iconia Tab back in January at CES, but gave almost nothing about it. Today we know that this is happening on pre-order in Best Buy stores from April 14 at \$449.99, and this 10.1-inch touchscreen tablet runs a dual-core 1GHz Nvidia Tegra 250 processor, with a 1280 by 800 pixel display, 1GB of RAM and two cameras. It has an aluminum chassis, and has Wi-Fi, but no 3G credentials. The fun of all is only the second tablet, after Motorola Xoom, to show Android 3.0 Honeycomb as its OS. This in itself is a code that has been the subject of speculation recently with Google, it seemed to keep it corralled and protected (presumably in order to perfect some of its early flaws) until exec Andy Rubin came forward to say Google wasn't protecting the OS at all. Honeycomb is Google's attempt to compete with the iPad on a par with Apple's iOS code, which has been optimized for both devices, as before version 3.0 Android was focused around the way smartphones work. Xoom has been touted as the first serious contender for the iPad (until its sales figures seemed to suggest that it wasn't bought by

anyone), so we can imagine that the A500 could earn some of the same attention. Speaking at the company's investor conference in Switzerland this week Acer Chairman and CEO J.T. Wang faced questions about the company's future and revealed good news probably born out of the latest personnel reshuffle. Instead of focusing on the volume of supplies of low-margin products to make a profit, Acer will change course in the future to deliver products that provide greater value to consumers and that consumers actually need. This is a notable change from the approach that Acer used during the netbook boom to capture the lion's share of the market. The plan emphasizes that Acer is actually trying to be flexible to change the market space despite its size, and now that the short-lived netbook is booming all but over, and the era of the pill has arrived (although Wang warned that it will be a slower transition than some people think). Acer can plan a big attack on Android and Windows-powered tablets-with some serious not aimed at the cheap end. Should Apple be worried? Maybe a little. Wang took time Note that Android tablet manufacturers may suffer fewer difficulty sourcing components than Apple because they have alternative supply channels available to them while Apple has very precise component needs. This may affect Apple in the short term (although Apple sales figures don't seem to offer very much). What Apple may have to fear is Acer is trying to undermine the iPad with a similar or slightly better-specced product at a slightly lower price, just as the A500-one times Honeycomb is improving and Windows 8 arrives on stage. For Google Android tablets, you need a Google account to be able to download apps and music from the Google Play store. If you already have a Gmail/google account address it can be used as an alternative, you can create one during the customization process. You just need to enter your name, the username you want to use as the beginning of your Gmail address and password. If you're moving to an Android tablet with an iPad, we recommend that you do it first before you start setting up a new tablet. How can I get all my contacts, music, photos and apps on my new Google Android tablet? If you've previously had a Google Android tablet, make sure your contacts are backed up by your Google account, and when you register your Google account on your new tablet, your contacts will be available. Make sure all your apps, passwords, and Wi-Fi settings are backed up by a selection of settings, and then back up and recover. Then, when you want a new Android tablet, select the recovery option from the previous backup device so that your settings and passwords are added to the new smartphone, and the apps are automatically downloaded. For photos, save them on Google Photos on your existing Android tablet, and then install the Google Photos app on a new tablet (it can be pre-loaded). If you have an iPad, download the free Google Drive app to your device. Open and howling with your Google account. Click on the menu on the left side and then select the Settings icon (in the form of cog) from here select the backup and then select the aspects you want to copy, such as contacts, calendar entries, and photos. Now click Start backup. It's worth ensuring your iPad is being charged as it may take some time. Once completed, start setting up the Android tablet according to the instructions on the screen logged into the Google account you used to log in Drive. Westend61Getty Images Can I Connect to the Internet, Why Am I Away From Home? Depending on what version of the Android tablet you have, you may be able to connect to the internet away from home. If you only have Wi-Fi, you'll need a wireless network in reach. To find one, head settings and then then and connect to the network. If you have a Wi-Fi and 4G tablet, you can access the internet when you are away from the wireless network using 4G, but you will need to purchase a sim either pre-loaded with data, or you need to sign a contract for data from the mobile network to allow you to do so. How can I back up my content time? When you first set up your tablet and enter your Google account details, you're asked if you want to build a backup device into your Google account and restore your previous backup device. Make sure this box is ticked and the content will back up. If you forget to do so, go to Settings, then back up and recover and turn back to Google Drive. It doesn't cover photos, so back them up to Google Photos (free from the Google Play Store if not yet installed on your tablet. Tablets are an expensive investment, costing between 200 and 700 pounds, so we recommend that you take insurance. Contact your home content provider and look at the cost of adding a tablet to the policy or try ProtectYourBubble - a dedicated provider of gadget insurance. because a broken screen is one of the most common accidents that have befallen tablet devices.
