Antonio Malgaroli got his degree 1985 in Medicine & Surgery and 1991 in the specialization on Psychiatry & Psychotherapy, both at the University of Milan. He is Full Professor in Physiology & Neuroscience, Faculty of Psychology - Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele (UniSR), where he teaches as well as at the Università della Svizzera Italiana (USI) in Lugano (CH). He is Director of the University Center for Behavioral Neuroscience & Communication - UniSR. Since his postdoctoral period at the Stanford University (US), his research has focused on brain plasticity in experimental animals and humans, with important contributions on the induction and modulation of these processes. During his career he has developed many innovative methods for the quantitative assessment of the activity of brain circuits and their plasticity, both in vitro and in vivo. In 2020 he was elected member of the European Organization for Scientific Research EMBO. As for his clinical activity, he practices in Milano and in Lugano. His main expertise relates to the pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatment of obsessive-compulsive disorders, addiction (from abuse substances and behavioral) and Tourette's syndrome. He is a member of the scientific board of the Italian Association for Tourette (AIST).
