## **Ministry Spotlight: ACTS 2**

The Acts 2 Benevolence Ministry is one of the most important ministries at 31st Street Baptist Church and probably one of the most misunderstood (but thank God for News Scope Spotlight articles!). While our Acts 2 Ministry officially kicked off at the top of 2025 in it's current form, it is really the combination of two older ministries of our church. For decades our Benevolence Ministry, led by the diaconate (Deacon body), was focused on providing assistance to 31st Street members who found themselves in need of assistance with rent, utilities, and other crucial needs. However, at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, with so many of our neighbors and church hill residents coming to the church office each week for tangible support- Dr. Mitchell launched the creation of the "31st Cares" Ministry- designed to provide the same kind of benevolence to non-members in need. "31st Cares" Ministry also provided funds to support organizations and ministries who needed assistance for important causes.

For a few years, our Benevolence Ministry and the 31<sup>st</sup> Cares Ministry worked as two separate ministries, but after the establishment of the non-profit 31<sup>st</sup> Cares Inc., it

it was decided that to avoid confusion- the "31st Cares" name would solely be utilized to identify the work of the non-profit entity and that all benevolence- for members and non-members- would fall under one ministry, now known as our Acts 2 Ministry. This measure was voted on and pass by the church in our 2024 annual Church meeting and in 2025, Acts 2 has been a blessing to both members in need and to our community. Most recently, the funds raised for Acts 2 were utilized to be a blessing to each of the 186 RIC Airport TSA workers who were employed during the governmental shutdown. The work of the ministry, through the generosity of our congregation, is literally helping to change and support lives in our church, community, and beyond.
