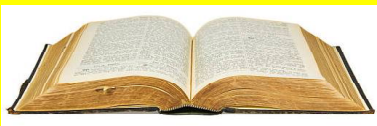

***How A Christian Can
Build our Nation***



Introduction

Romans 13:1-6

Let every soul be in subjection to the higher authorities, for there is no authority except from God, and those who exist are ordained by God...

For rulers are not a terror to the good work, but to the evil. Do you desire to have no fear of the authority? Do that which is good, and you will have praise from the same, for he is a servant of God to you for good.

But if you do that which is evil, be afraid, for he doesn't bear the sword in vain; for he is a minister of God, an avenger for wrath to him who does evil.

Therefore you need to be in subjection, not only because of the wrath, but also for conscience' sake. For this reason you also pay taxes, for they are ministers of God's service, attending continually on this very thing.



Introduction

Pray for our leaders - 1 Timothy 2:1-3 *I exhort therefore, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and givings of thanks, be made for all men: for kings and all who are in high places; that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior*

Live worthy - Philippians 1:27 *Only let your manner of life be worthy of the Gospel of Christ, that, whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your state, that you stand firm in one spirit, with one soul striving for the faith of the Gospel;*

Dual citizenship - Ephesians 2:19 *So then you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God.*

Galatians 2:10 *Only they would that we should remember the poor; the same which I also was forward to do.*

1 Thessalonians 5:14 *Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.*

Galatians 4:16 *Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?*

Romans 12:20 *Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.*

Luke 6:27-28 *But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.*

2 Thessalonians 3:15 *Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.*
