You can adjust the depth of cut of this edge by lifting or lowering the lever near the front wheel bracket. Moving the lever forward increases the cutting blade and its further rearward movement increases the depth of cut. The maximum depth of cut is 1.75 inches, which is sufficient for most jobs, and the machine has six depth settings. However, the blade cannot be adjusted to an angle, only vertically. This will be limiting for some users. To increase the life of the blade, you can pass through the same area several times, gradually lowering the blade with each passage. Unlike you for gas edges with two-wheel engines, you don't need to mix oil with gas to use a four-cycle Troy-Bilt engine. The tank has a 0.4 quartet of gasoline, which is not the largest capacity we've seen, so you may want to keep the gas close. A four-cycle engine is more efficient than a two-wheel engine, which means it is less harmful to the environment. The primer bulb helps to draw fuel into the chamber, making the Troy-Bilt TB516 EC easier to start. The machine operates at temperatures below 40 degrees by first heating the engine. If the engine starts to heat up because you are dealing with an area with excessive overgrowth, you can lift the blade, allowing the engine to idle and cool down. The carrying weight for this edger is 22 pounds, making it relatively light and easier to move than the heavier model. This light weight, in addition to three fixed wheels, makes it easier to operate, even on slightly uneven terrain.
