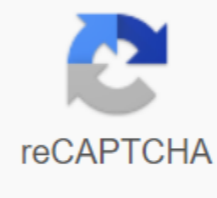

Similarly, we may use the adverb to formulate a proposal with an opinion or attitude. In this case, the word tells us how the reader feels about the rest of the sentence. For example: Ideally, we will move into a new house next month. Fortunately, Thomas was not injured in the incident. Here, perfect and fortunately tell us the author's attitude about what is expressed in the rest of the relevant sentence. If you use a word to enter a sentence like this, always include a comma.
