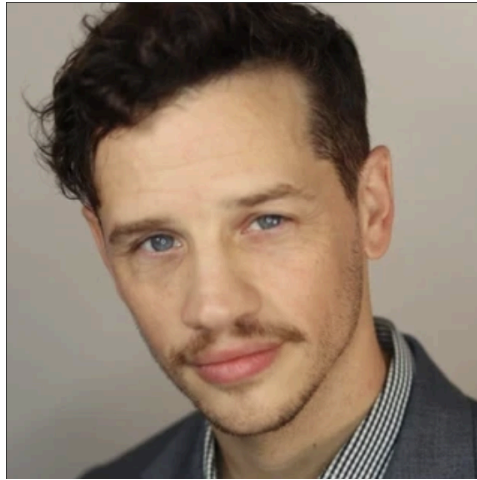




Jeffery Mazziotta
