

## How to Enable Parental Controls on iPads:

You can use Restrictions, also known as parental controls, to block or limit specific apps and features on your iPad, including access to explicit content in the iTunes Store.

1. Launch the **Settings** app from the Home screen of your iPad.
2. Tap on **General** midway down the list.
3. Tap on **Restrictions** midway down the list
4. Tap on **Enable Restrictions** if they're not enabled already. Don't forget this passcode. In the future, you'll need your Restrictions passcode to change your Settings or to turn off Restrictions.
5. Enter a **Passcode**. It's highly recommended that you don't share this Restrictions Password with your children for Parental Controls.
6. **Note: If you lose or forget your Restrictions passcode, you'll need to erase your device and then set it up as a new device to remove the Restrictions passcode. Restoring the device using a backup won't remove the passcode.**

## How to change your Restrictions Passcode:

If you want to change your Restrictions Passcode after you turn Restrictions on:

- Tap **Settings** -> **General**-> **Restrictions**.
- Tap **Disable Restrictions**.
- Enter your current Restrictions Passcode.
- Tap **Enable Restrictions**, then enter a new Passcode.
