

PLACES & EXPERIENCES

There is a difference between places and experiences. It generally has to do with the 'time' it takes to do it. Some sites are both places and experiences.

Place: The National Theatre is a good example of a place. It is somewhere where you want to visit and take a picture, but there isn't much more to do unless an event is being held there.

Experience: The Military Museum in Kumasi is a good example of an experience. There are some things to take pictures of, but the stories are what make it special. This is not a five minute thing. It takes at least an hour to get the full effect.

Place & Experience: The Jamestown Lighthouse is an example of something that you can just see or experience further. Many people just walk by, take a picture, and keep walking. For them it's just a place. Others will get someone to take them up the stairs and look out over the city and out to the ocean. Sometimes they are told a story. That is an experience because it takes much longer.
