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Growing up I admit that instead of reading previous Harry Potter books, I listened to them on film, from the fine unabridged version recorded by Jim Dale. I decided to dip into print with Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix, and I'm glad I did. I can still listen to Jim Dale's version, but holding 900 pages of the book felt good and I anxiously turned every page to find out what had happened. Phoenix is a darker book than previous ones, and Harry's teen emotions fluctuate in each chapter. Here's an excerpt of Harry's emotions, edging him into trouble (p. 242-3). It's a class scene from Chapter 12, with Professor Ambridge, the new defense teacher against the dark arts: There was a brief silence in which many class members turned heads to frown on a three-goal course, still written on the board. Using defensive spells? Professor Ambridge repeated with a little laughter. Why, I can't imagine any situation in my class that would require you to use a defensive spot, Miss Granger. You certainly don't expect to be attacked during class? We're not going to use magic? Ron ejaculated loudly. Students raise their hands when they want to speak in my class, Mr. ? ? Weasley, Ron said, pushing his hand into the air. Professor Ambridge, smiling even more broadly, turned his back on him. Harry and Hermione immediately raised their hands too. Professor Ambridge momentarily lingered on Harry's face before she turned to Hermione. Yes, Miss Granger? Did you want to ask something else? Yes, Hermione replied. Surely the whole point of Aainst's defense dark art is to practice defensive spells? Are you a Ministry of Education expert, Miss Granger? Asked Professor Ambridge in her falsely sweet voice. No, but - Well, then, I'm afraid you're not qualified to decide that the whole point is any class. Wizards are much older and smarter than you have developed our new training program. You'll learn about defensive spells in a safe, risk-free way - What's the benefit?, Harry said loudly. If we're going to be attacked he won't be in -- Hand, Mr. Potter! Professor Ambridge sang. Harry put his fist in the air. Professor Ambridge quickly turned away from them again, but now a few other people had their hands up too. ... While you've studied the theory hard enough, there's no reason why you shouldn't be able to perform spells in carefully controlled examination conditions, Professor Ambridge said dismissively. Never practiced them before? Said Parvati indredulously. Are you telling me that the first time we get to do spells will be during our exam? I repeat, as long as you've been studying theory hard enough And what good theory will be in the real world? Said Harry loudly, fist in the air again. Professor Ambridge looked up. This is school, Mr. Potter, not the real world, she said quietly. So we don't have to be prepared for what's waiting there? There is nothing waiting out there, Mr. Potter. Yes? Harry said. His character, which seemed to be bubbling just below the surface all day, reached boiling point. Who do you want to attack children like you? Asked Professor Ambridge in a horribly honeyed voice. Hmm, let's think about it. . . . said Harry in a mock thoughtful voice: Maybe Lord Voldemort? Ron a breathed, Lavender Brown uttered a small cry, Neville slipped sideways from his chair. Professor Ambridge, however, did not flinch. She looked at Harry with a darkly pleased expression. Ten points from Gryffindor, Mr. Potter. Many students will enjoy this line: This is a school, Mr. Potter, not the real world. The theme of growing up and the influence of age appears at the end of the book in this quote from Dumbledore (p. 826): For I see now that what I have done, not done, in relation to you, bears all the hallmarks of age flaws. Young people cannot know how age thinks and feels. But the old men are guilty if they forget that it was to be young... and I seem to have forgotten lately. Even Dumbledore seems vulnerable in Phoenix, and for this reason alone, you can enjoy reading this latest, and in my opinion, the best installment in the series.
