Congratulations! On behalf of the [Computerworld Honors Program](#)®, which is governed by the Computerworld Information Technology Awards Foundation, I am pleased to confirm that your Case Study for "Palm Handhelds and Smartphones" has been received and approved as a "Laureate" for 2007.

While we will soon mail you a formal invitation, we are now providing you with online links to enable you to register for the event as the "Laureate" representative of your company. Information on our website will be posted shortly, however, the date, time, location and details for the event are noted below.

Both events take place on the same day. The venue is the historic Andrew Mellon Auditorium (<http://www.mellonauditorium.com/>) on Constitution Avenue in Washington, DC and the date is June 4, 2007.

The first event is the Laureate Medal Ceremony at Noon. This is an approximately 90 minute agenda and medal ceremony where one representative from each 2007 Laureate organization will receive their Laureate Gold Medal formally on-stage. You may invite guests to the Noon Laureate's Ceremony, but all guests will need to be pre-registered prior to the event. **Registration begins promptly at 10:30am and all Laureates must be registered by 11:30am.**

The second event is the evening black tie gala dinner and awards program starting at 6:00pm. The evening features a full program of presentations, announcement of the annual Leadership Awards, announcement of the 50 Finalists for 2007 (5 in each of 10 categories of nomination), and the finale of individual presentations to the Honoree in each category of the 21st Century Achievement Award. The evening program includes a cocktail reception, elegant dinner, program and entertainment.

As a 2007 Laureate, you will receive one complimentary ticket for yourself for the evening program. Should you wish to have someone accompany you, please note this when you register for the day's events. No one may attend the dinner without prior registration as it is by invitation only. **All guests must be approved.**

The registration links are as follows. Please ensure your registration (and requests) are submitted by **April 30, 2007 at the latest**. Please note that our online registration is a 2-step process. You will receive an email confirmation that your registration has been *received*. As this is an invitation-only formal event, all online registrations are personally reviewed and once accepted, a second and final confirmation will be automatically sent to you.
