LETTER RECOGNITION & KNOWLEDGE

LISTENING SKILLS

- The ability to retain and recall different elements of the reading process.

PRINT AWARENESS

- The understanding of letter versus words, words versus sentences, etc. The knowledge of how to approach text.



MOTIVATION

- The excitement to read and be read to, to explore text, to share and display reading knowledge.

Recite all letters of the alphabet
Recognize all the letters of the alphabet
Match capital & lowercase letters
Associate letters with sounds
Write all letters of the alphabet

Phonological Awareness Checklist

Learns & recites nursery rhymes with ease
 Associates letters with the correct sounds
 Identifies rhyming words
 Identifies beginning & ending sounds of words
 Understands long & short vowel sounds

Listening Skills Checklist

Pays attention during story time
 Answers questions about the story read
 Retells story in his or her own words
 Asks questions during story time

Print Awareness Checklist

- Reads left to right

 Starts a book at front cover ends at back cover
- Knows a letter is different from a word
- Recognizes letters in different fonts
