Traditional Devon Fruit Trees for Woolacombe Community Allotment

On a blustery cold day in early March 20 fruit trees were planted in the allotment under the expert guidance of Paul South from the National Trust. The trees were part of an initative in Devon to plant traditional species of native trees to the County of Devon. These included the wonderfully named Red Sentinel; Devonshire Quarrenden; Lucombes Pine: Oaken Pin; Pigs Snout: Tiddicombe Seedling; Totness Apple; Devonshire Buckland; Peter Lock: Ellis Bitter and Tremletts Bitter.

The trees were chosen as varieties fitted for the challenging conditions to be found in coastal environments.

New Bench Seat for Mortehoe Play Area - Councillor Wilkinson provided a grant from his Community Grant scheme to replace the broken elderly bench seat in Mortehoe Play area. The new multi-coloured seat has proved highly popular with the young children enjoying the play equipment at the area.
