He has written several books, including four that won the ECPA Christian Book Award (1994, 1999, 2001 and 2005), a series that tackles the challenge of Christian truthability. [Strobel] has also been interviewed on numerous national television shows, including ABC's 20/20, Fox News and CNN, which host a TV show called Face Under Fire on PAX TV[4] and run a video apologetics website. A life and career strobel, he was born in Arlington Heights, Illinois. He earned a journalism degree from the University of Missouri, a master's degree in law from Yale Law School, and spent 14 years as a journalist for newspapers such as the Chicago Tribune. In 1980, the UPI Illinois Editorial Association Newspaper Awards program gave him the no. 1 official duties (Len H. Small Memorial Award) for its coverage of Ford Motor's Pinto crash trial in Waukegan, Indiana. [6] Strobel later became assistant managing editor of the Daily Herald before leaving journalism in 1987. [8] Strobel was a member of the church when he began investigating biblical claims about Christ after his wife's conversion. Prompted by the results of the investigation, he became a Christian at the age of 29. [10] Strobel taught pastors at Willow Creek Community Church in South Barrington, Illinois, from 1987 to 2000 before shifting his focus to writing and producing the TV show Face Under Fire. [12] He continues to speak regularly at churches and serves on the board of the Willow Creek Society. In 2007, he was awarded an honorary doctorate by Southern Evangelical Seminary in recognition of his contribution to Christian apologetics. Strobel and his wife, Leslie, have two children and several grandchildren [daughter Alison is a novelist and his son Kyle is an assistant professor of spiritual theology and formation at Talbot Theology School. Selected Works Case for Christ's Book sums up Lee's interviews with 13 evangelists—Scholars—Craig Bronberg, Bruce Metzger, Edwin Yamauchi, John McCray, Gregory Boyd, Ben Witherington III, Gary Collins, D.A. Carson, Louis Lajides, Alexander Meterle, William Lane Craig,

Gary Habermas, and J.P. Moreland defend their views on the credibility of history. Strobel's personal experience met these scholars and their beliefs and was portrayed in the 2017 drama film of the same name. In his book *Case for Faith: Journalists Investigate the Harshes Objections to Christianity*, Strobel answers doubts about Christianity, including the problems of evil, the contradiction between miracles and science, whether It is worth worshipping if God kills innocent children, whether Jesus is the only way to God, and the church's history of oppression and violence. *Case for Creators* *Case for Creators* The case for creators consists of interviews with intellectual design advocates and Christian apologists who advocate the existence of creators. [19] The other book Strobel states that he wrote in Harry and Mary's minds outside the church to advance people's understanding of Christianity and to help increase the effectiveness of missionary efforts, and that it contains insights drawn from his own experience as a former atheist on why people avoid Christianity. [20] The experience of Jesus' passion was co-written with Garry Poole as a discussion guide to Mel Gibson's film *The Passion of Christ*. Strobel and Poole also co-authored the search for the Da Vinci Code.
