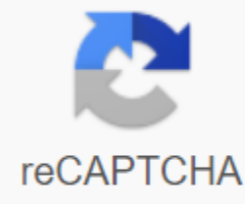

Josephine county jail inmate mail

Inmates' accounts you can place money into the prisoner's account using the prisoner canteen online. Inmates can have up to \$200.00 in their inmate account, allowing them to purchase commissary items such as snacks and hygiene items. Medical accounts and any money owed from a previous stay will be deducted from their account. Other options for the commissary: Josephine County Adult Prison uses TurnKey as our commissioners supplier. TurnKey offers a service that allows friends and family of prisoners to purchase selected items for the prisoner during their stay. These purchases are made entirely online using the Turnkey website. Purchases cannot be completed through the kiosk lobby or through prison staff. The Real Estate and Post Josephine County Adult Jail will not accept any inmates' property other than prescription drugs that have been approved by the Prison Medical Clinic. Clothing, books, toiletries, over-the-counter medications and other different types are not accepted by prison staff. In addition, the prison does not release the prisoner's property by going to prison without supervision. Generally, only prisoners sentenced to prison could vacate property while in detention. Prisoner Mail Prison accepts letters the size of envelopes and postcards. The mail intended to contact the prisoner must contain the full name and address of the sender. The prisoner's mail must be marked with the name of the prisoner and addressed to the Josephine County Adult Prison. Any items that do not meet these standards will not be delivered to prisoners. Josephine County Adult Prison's Postal Address: 1901 NE F Street, Grants Pass, OR 97526 Any letters with excessive writing or photos will not be delivered. Polaroid-style photos are not allowed. Any letters or postcards with lipstick, perfume or any other foreign substance will not be accepted on them and will be returned to the sender. Non-compliance with the prison mail policy is considered a violation of mail. You can unofficially mourn this violation by contacting the captain of the Josephine County Jail within 48 hours. Cash orders, checks and cash are not accepted through the postal system. Prisoners can have newspapers and books sent to the facility and must be delivered by postal service or carriers such as UPS or FedEx. Books can only be paperback, and must be sent by a professional bookseller or Amazon. No books can be sent by private prisoners. The prisoner's personal mail will be scanned by prison staff for security reasons. If you are looking for information about any inmate currently housed in the Josephine County Jail, you can visit the Prisoner Search/Registry In here. You can also call 541-474-5140 to find out about the prisoner. Note: Keep prisoner information like full name, age, gender, date of birth and prisoner ID at hand. If you are still unable to locate the prisoner, you may search on the Oregon Inmates Search page. You can send any mail to inmates who are in prison/prison. For further clarification on permitted subjects, please contact the prison administration directly at 541-474-5140. Note: In case you want to send packages, you must obtain prior authorization from the prison administration. Contact prison/prison staff for more information. You may not use our service or the information it provides to make decisions about consumer credit, employment, insurance, tenant screening or any other purpose that requires FCRA compliance. The pigeon understand how difficult it is for families to stay away from their inmate, and it is important to familiarize yourself with the basic inmate visits before planning a visit as each facility has specific rules that you should follow. All visitors must be pre-approved; your inmate must put you on a pre-approved visiting list in order for you to visit them, which is later reviewed by the correctional facility. In considering an application, correctional facilities consider many factors, as all formalities must be made. Many sites limit the number of visitors, so prisoners must narrow down the list of potential visitors. All correctional facilities have their own set of rules to follow. You will have to follow prison rules, no matter how arbitrary they may seem when you visit. The prisoner you plan to visit should be able to inform you of the schedule of visiting

this prison, however it is always a good idea to call the prison before ensuring a visit is allowed and whether potential visitors are approved or not. Once a visitor has been approved by a correctional facility, they should check with their inmate on what days they may visit. All prisoners are searched before and after any visits for security reasons. Families visiting their inmates must abide by the dress code of a particular prison, otherwise they may be denied access. All visitors are expected to submit a valid, government issued photo ID. Pigeonly also introduced video visits to connect families and prisoners when it becomes difficult for them to visit, you need to first schedule a visit and it is approved by your prisoner's facility by signing up with pigeonly video visiting your prisoner will in one click. Before visiting the prisoner, check all the rules that must be followed. You can find an inmate at the Josephine County Jail using a Pigeonly Prisoner search if you need help before visiting. Each agency requires them to follow their rules to local ordinances. Usually for any given institution you want to make sure to wear the appropriate outfit. Make sure your outfits aren't too tight. Different states may have different rules on clothing. For information on what to wear in Oregon, be sure to check your relevant Oregon Department of Corrections laws on your state's official website. Each inmate facility has different procedures, so in the case of Josephine County Jail Josephine County the general list of items that are prohibited is as follows, however, please check the Josephine County Jail's Department of Corrections website to get the entire list. The following items are strictly prohibited: Mobile phones / Cameras / Video cameras / Recording devices; Cigarettes/Tobacco; Drugs, syringes or any other drug paraphernalia; Weapons (weapons, knives, etc.); Chemicals / flammable liquids / explosives; Medications: over-the-counter, prescribed or herbal (transportation of diabetic pens and epi-pens, subject to approval by the superintendent); Alcohol and alcohol products; Bags for personal property, opaque (i.e. briefcases, backpacks, bags, wallets, etc.); Personal property, including keys (except for the keys to the visitor reception center's locker), money, personal identification; Electronic game consoles, MP3 players, iPods, electronic storage devices including USB flash drives, memory drives and heart rate monitors (except when approved by a superintendent); MLiti-media items, CDs, DVDs, movies, videos, banned publications; Electronic items, including rechargeable toothbrushes, razors, clippers, etc. (except for medical reasons, subject to the approval of the superintendent); Lighters, matches, candles, incense, spray spray spray can; Any food or drink; Metal cutlery / glass bottles or glass containers, opaque lunch boxes; Colors/patches/gang identification and related clothing; Paint, pens and lights with opaque body, scissors, knitted needles; Tattoo materials, tools, scales, magnet/magnetic devices. Inmates must complete a visitor registration form and submit it to the Josephine County Jail, those approved on this form will be allowed to visit. Before visiting, all approved visitors must show a valid ID. All visitors must be aged 18. Minors are not allowed without the support of their parents or legal guardian. Please contact the Josephine County Jail for synchronization. Contact the Josephine County Jail for visitation rules, as only four states currently allow spousal visits. County Jail Asks visitors to schedule a visit one day in advance to avoid trouble while visiting your prisoner, all visitors are invited to arrive at least 15 minutes. Visitors must show a valid photo ID when registering. Visitors must register with the prisoner visiting system before planning planning with a prisoner. Walk-in visits are welcome but available on a first come first basis and can be accessed. Contact the Josephine County Jail to plan a visit with an inmate. Contact the Josephine County Jail to schedule an appointment with the inmate and check the time slot, as inmates are allowed one visit a day. Visitors should check the dates and rules before visiting the prison. Booking a prison visit online is simple as it takes about 5 minutes of your time. This allows you to choose 3 slots instead of one, and you can check with your inmate or Josephine County jail to visit the clock. The prisoner must add you to his visitor list before booking a visit. You must set up an online account with the Josephine County Jail to book a slot online, once this is confirmed by the Josephine County Jail, you can visit your inmate. Video Visiting is a convenient way to contact an inmate without traveling to prison or writing to an inmate, these video visits can be held at home with your laptop or Android mobile device as it saves you time and expense. Children can now also communicate without visiting the institution. Visitors must set up an account at the Josephine County Jail and get its approved facility in order to use the service. Prisons are being replaced by a personal visit via a video visit in order to avoid huge traffic and make it convenient for the prisoner's families. All calls collected are approved by josephine County Jail and billed through your phone carrier company. Calling inmates is a service provided to all inmates to contact their friends and families, in order to use this service, all inmates must register at the Josephine County Jail family and friends can contact their inmates in the prison through collection of calls. You must be on your prisoner-approved phone list. Please note that cell phones cannot receive calls, you need to have an established prepaid account, contact us to create an account and start communicating with your inmates. There are of course items that you should not bring as well, for example: Medications of any kindcigarettes or tobacco-related productsAnything that can be considered or used as weapons, any person who visits a prisoner is subject to inspection and may be arrested if they have any active warrants. Contact with prisoners is usually limited or restricted for various reasons and for security reasons of others. Correctional officers will also let you know if you are going overseas as well. Usually You can wear jewelry when visiting your loved one. When you arrive just make sure you take it off before you go through the metal detector so it doesn't go. We now strongly recommend that your loved one get rules from the facility so that you don't work out any inconvenience. First of all in all prisons there are rules dictating who is actually allowed to visit a prisoner during the specified hours. In general, this list includes: Immediate family membersRehabilitized relativesRecoil (usually approved list of less than 10 people) Religious leadersSponsorEmployersAttorneys On the other hand, there are a number of reasons you may not be allowed to visit a loved one in prison, for example, if you have an outstanding warrant, you have an active order of protection against you, you are currently on probation or parole or you are considered a security risk. While individuals who have previously been convicted of crimes may face tough time admitted as prison visitors, they will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Basis.
