Normally, you should sign in to Minecraft for the first time before you play offline. To use offline free mode (Pro 1.5.2 Users) Download and run Minecraft 1.5.2 Launcher (Here: Put in username (It does not need to be registered with Mojang) Leave password blank Click Login, then click Play Offline (If this mod is not installed, it will say Un downloaded) Note: You can only play offline for free with the old launcher (1.5.2 and below). It's because the launcher has been updated with version 1.6.2. However, if you purchased Minecraft 1.6.2 and receive an Unsanned error, that program will fix it. I've been having a similar problem where I try to play Minecraft on a network where Mojang servers are blocked by a firewall. In the past I was able to play offline in these situations, but when I tried using the latest version at the time (1.8.3), still trying to download files, and fail because they were blocked or my wireless card was turned off and it would fail to start. I tried to make a new profile and use an older version of Minecraft that was once completely downloaded on my computer in an unblocked network (1.8.1). I forced my profile to use this version of Minecraft, and I was able to open the Minecraft client successfully without downloading any other software, such as MCPatcher (which I also can't download because MCForums are blocked here). It seems that minecraft client requires any version you use to download all files for this version locally to your computer. Whenever I tried opening 1.8.3, I kept trying to download files related to Minecraft Realms that I don't even need to play offline or so I would have thought. For future reference purposes, my client output can be found here for failed attempts. If you like playing Minecraft, then it's logical that you're looking for ways to play the game offline. To be fair, you can get a lot when you play Minecraft without an active Internet connection. For one, you can avoid installing updates that may be buggy or bad. Some updates do more harm than good after By playing Minecraft offline, you can shortening the delay. If the game is configured to play without an Internet connection on your computer, you won't need to verify your credentials at the beginning of each Minecraft session.
