

3) Provincial Job Vacancy

Volunteer wanted for Adelphi database

In conjunction with United Grand Lodge, the Provincial Grand Chapter Administration at Bromsgrove maintains a database containing details of Companions in the Province including their appointments in Chapter and in Provincial Grand Chapter. The database, called "Adelphi" also contains details of appointments in the Craft and is also accessed by Provincial Grand Lodge. Grand Lodge maintains the system for all its membership records.

Because the system was set up by Grand Lodge, a detailed knowledge of its capabilities is not available to the PGC Administration in Bromsgrove.

In order to help develop a knowledge base, the MEGS wishes to appoint a volunteer who is a member of the Royal Arch in the Province of Worcestershire to identify how the database can be used to provide meaningful reports and information to him and his Executive and to train and support the Administration to produce such reports.

Applicants are invited from subscribing Companions of the Provincial Grand Chapter of Worcestershire who consider they have and can demonstrate the necessary skills to undertake this role on a voluntary basis. It is anticipated that the role will only take a few hours a week and, whilst some of that time may be spent at home, attendance at the Provincial Office at Bromsgrove during normal office hours will be required particularly when training and support is required.
