Having Opened the Chapter early the Companions stood to Order at the 11th Hour in Remembrance of all those who have given their lives in the protection of this country.

On completion of its normal business the Chapter was Closed and then received a most poignant and exceptionally well delivered talk from E. Comp. Revd. Dr. John R H Railton, **PGSwdB**, **Past DepGS**, (Wilts) on "The Unknown Warrior."
