The following guidelines for giving may help you determine your pledge. They were adapted from UUA models:

Annual Income	Percentage of income	Annual
\$ 10,000	1.0%	\$100
20,000	2.0%	400
30,000	2.5%	750
40,000	3.0%	1,200
50,000	3.5%	1,750
Over 60,000	4.0%	2,400 +
Over 100,000	4.5%	4,500 +
