Grace Kids-

July was a struggle with volunteers being gone and number of kids showing up was hard to predict. Hoping this fall will bring consistency with volunteers.

Amy and Mel met Tuesday morning to have a 4th quarter strategy session for scheduling gracekids. There's a couple people we need to onboard and really determine if we can count on them to show up when they're scheduled otherwise classrooms will be closed. The couple people we gained over the last push for volunteers have either been inconsistent or aren't ready to lead and now losing a whole family puts us short on two classroom leaders (Nursery and 56).

We've rearranged teachers with summer softball/baseball families coming back so that takes some of the pressure off Amy and I but with both of us working full time during the week it's not realistic for both of us to teach/fill in every Sunday as we have been the majority of the last year. It's not just July/summer. I need 3 people on reserve every Sunday to check in and be ready to be plugged in if someone doesn't show up.

Guest Services-

Wins- I think implementing the New Guest Social has been a great addition to our church and guests. The first one seemed to be a success and there are several signed up for this next one!

Struggles - People not able to serve months out of the year and it being difficult finding others to fill in; people not giving a heads up that they cannot serve until Friday or Saturday before

their Sunday to serve (for this, I could, and probably will, begin sending a reminder text earlier in the week... although everyone is aware of the Sunday they have signed up for. Updates - I have accepted a practicum position with DCCCA in Wichita to complete my Master's in December of this year. With that, it might be a good idea to start taking note of who might be a good fit for the Guest Services position next. There is not a rush - I don't plan on giving up this position any time soon, but I think it is best to prepare for the future. I want what is best for our church, so as much as I want to remain Guest Services Director, I need to make sure I am not neglecting the time and energy it deserves.
