

The best opportunity to do this is the upcoming parliamentary and presidential elections in October and November of 2006." "Slim Assouly is a Tunisian who emerged from a modest background to become the country's most famous and controversial populist leader. He is a talented orator, a committed socialist, and a fierce critic of both the traditional ruling class and Tunisian secular elites." "Nidaa Tounes, the party he founded in May 2006, swept to a stunning victory in the October 2006 parliamentary elections. He's a controversial figure and his methods and rhetoric have been criticized by some, but his popularity seems to have grown in recent months. For the first time in decades, the young people
