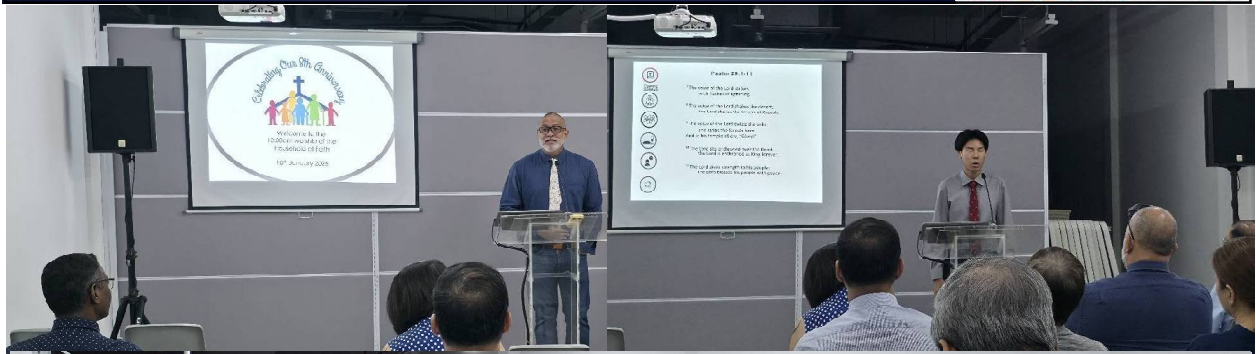



Application: Surround yourself with His people: seek wise counsel and prayers from people.

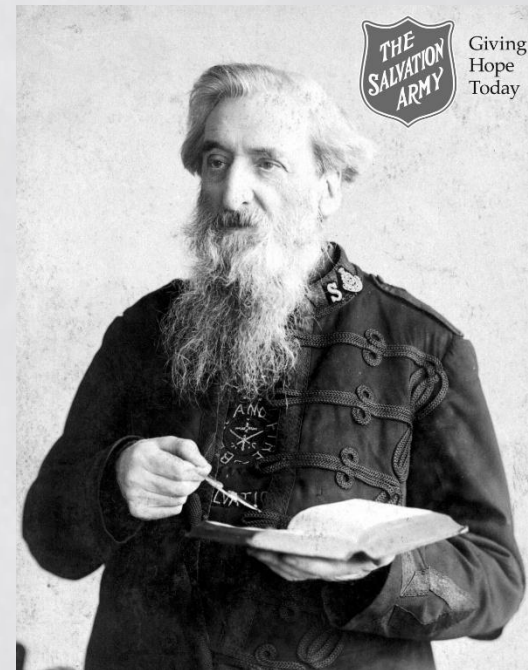
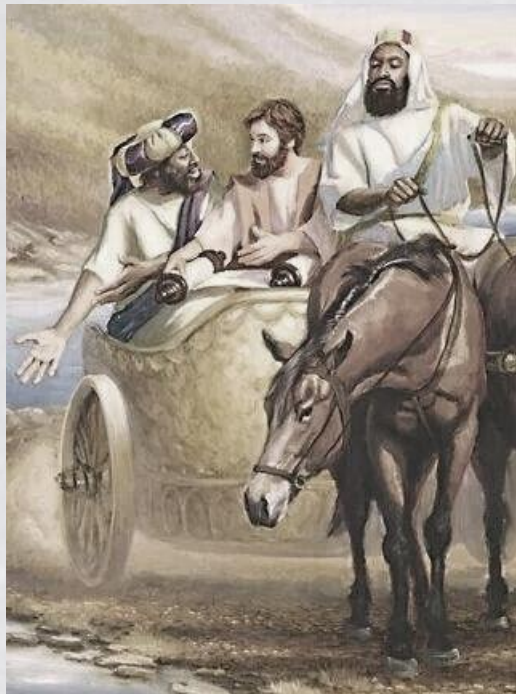

Romans 1:20 (NIV)

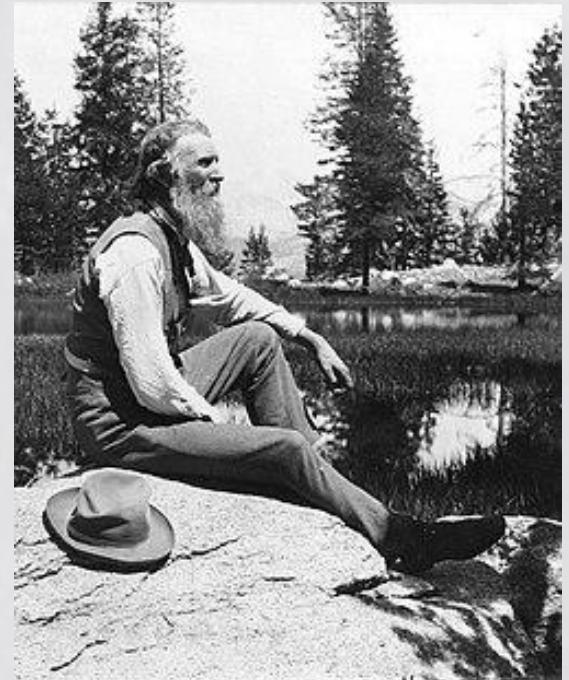


Application: Spend time in His creation (eg. Walking in the park)

Psalm 46:10 (ESV)



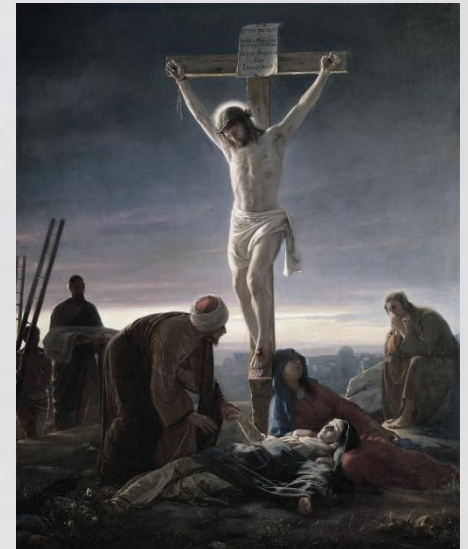
Application: Silence is not absence. God uses quiet moments to refine faith, build character, and prepare hearts for His revelation.


#5 By His Tugging (Application)

A gentle nudge: A quiet inner voice or feeling prompting you to act or pray for someone.

A deep yearning: A sense that your soul longs for something more, a connection only God can fulfill.

Intuitive guidance: A strong sense of "should" or "shouldn't" that guide decisions, even if they seem illogical at first.

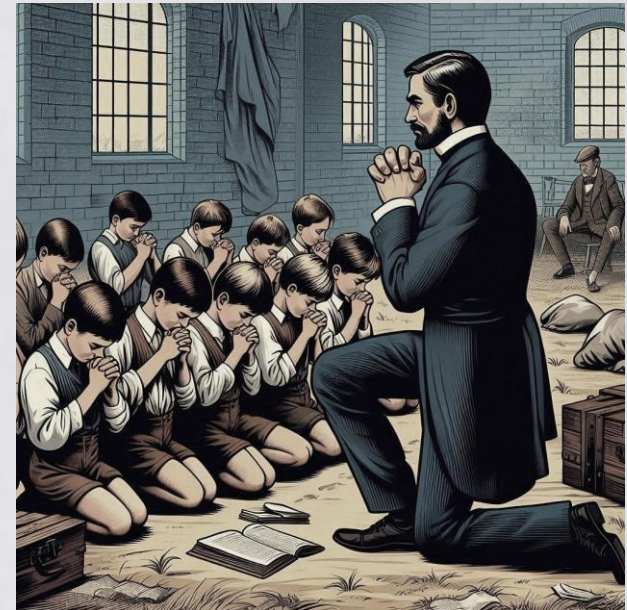
A call to holiness: A pulling towards righteousness and away from worldly desires.

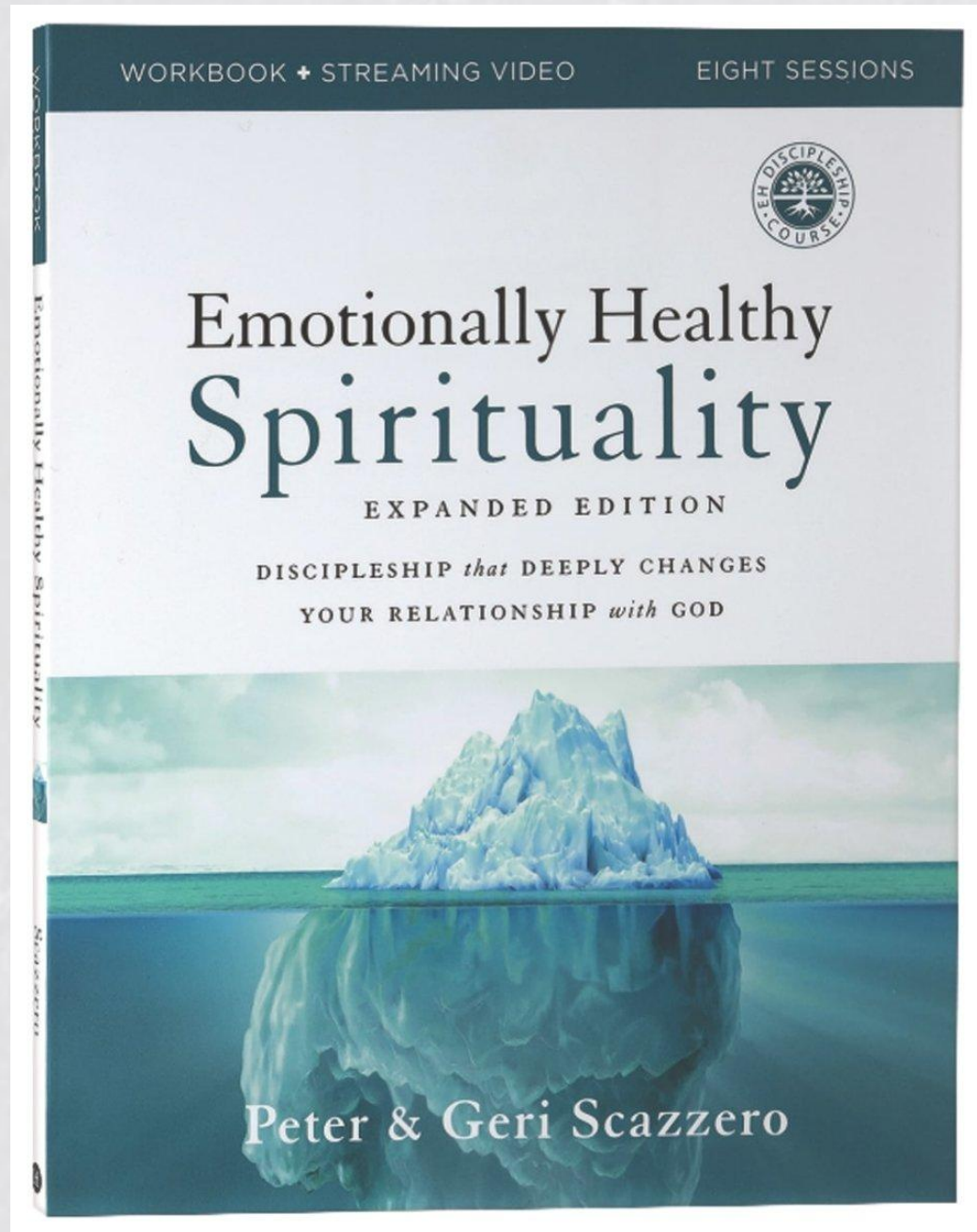

Centering Prayer (Exercise)

Step 1: Sit down and take a few deep breaths to settle into God's presence.

Step 2: Choose a simple phrase or word as an anchor for this prayer time. (Eg. "Be still", "Rest", "Shalom" or bible verse)

Step 3: Close your eyes and become aware of God's presence with you now.

Step 4: When you become distracted, use the phrase to re-center yourself in God's presence.
