2. Asset Licensing

- ☐ All images, icons, videos, and other digital assets are either free for commercial use or properly licensed.
- ☐ Proof of license or usage rights for any paid or third-party assets is filed and accessible.
- ☐ No stock assets with personal, editorial, or restricted licenses are used.

3. Contractors & Designers

- ☐ All designers and contractors have been reminded of and have agreed to comply with the licensing policy.
- ☐ Any third-party contributions (e.g., Figma files) have been checked for compliance with the above font and asset policies.

4. Social Media, Advertising & Other Uses

- ☐ Check that no website fonts or assets will be repurposed for social media, apps, or advertising without verifying their license coverage.

- ☐ If reuse is planned, confirm license terms permit these use cases.

5. Compliance Sign-Off

- ☐ All relevant licenses and usage rights are documented and stored in the project files.
- ☐ This checklist has been completed and signed before going live.
