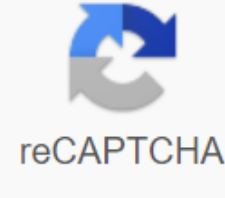

The BPSC Syllabus is established by the Bihar Public Service Commission. The Commission is constitutionally empowered to assist the Bihar Government in recruitment, transfer and disciplinary matters, the BPSC (Combined Competitive Examination) exam is conducted in three stages: Prelims - 1 objective type of paper for 150 Mains marks - 4 descriptive documents (1 qualifying 3 merit ratings) Interview - 120 Grade applicants can check the detailed BPSC exam template in a related article. The 65th combined competitive exam or 65th CCE BPSC is currently under way, and BPSC has also issued a training program, recruitment notice, vacancies, selection conditions, etc. with the 66th BPSC notification. In history, candidates must also focus on economic, political and social aspects. In both history and geography, candidates must prepare the history and geography of Bihar. In accordance with geography, the issues will also be based on the socio-economic geography of Bihar and India, including Indian agriculture and the use of natural resources. Within the Indian economy and policy, the issues will cover the following topics: political system Panchayati Raj planning community development in India and Bihar as part of the Indian national movement, candidates candidates focus on the rebirth of the 19th century, the nature and rise of nationalism in India, and the independence of India. In addition, Bihar's role in the Indian National Movement is important from the point of view of the BPSC exam. Check the BPSC eligibility criteria here. BPSC Mains Syllabus Candidates who clear the prelims stage will be eligible for BPSC Mains. Approximately the number of candidates selected for the Mains will be 10 times the total number of vacancies. BPSC's 64th CCE Mains result was July 16, 2020. The exact date of the exam has not yet been announced; it will be announced soon. In addition, the Commission also announced the results of the 63rd Combined Competitive Pre-examination on 9 September 2018 (additional result on 18 September).
