For example, you could say, A new math curriculum has been developed and implemented, resulting in 48% improvement in government test results. Tailor every resume to work with. If you are applying for several different positions in different learning environments, make sure you adapt your resume to each job opening. You want to highlight different aspects of your experience depending on the specific position requirements available. Read the job posting carefully and make sure the relationship between your experience and position requirements is very clear in your resume. One way to do this is to include keywords in a summary of the job list. Look for important words on the job list, such as qualifications, skills, etc., and include them on your resume to demonstrate that you are a good fit for the job. Let's look at the format.
