Role Background

The Project Officer will also prepare and publish digital content for Oorja's social media platforms and website and manage all organisational communications. The ideal candidate is technology-savvy with excellent written communication and analytical skills.

Key Duties

- Digitise and analyse customer and site data for needs assessment and site selection
- Select and assess new partner organisations viz. NGOs, farmer producer organisations; liaise with existing partners
- Design and conduct quantitative and qualitative impact Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E)
- Collect, clean, store and manage both qualitative and quantitative data
- Prepare progress and project reports; report to investors and funders
- Create and publish content for social media, website, monthly newsletters and other publications
- Liaise with technology vendors

Project Management

- Digitalisation of data collected from needs assessments and site surveys prior to implementation of solar projects
- Developing and maintaining a pipeline of feasible and shortlisted project sites
- Analysis and presentation of demographic, socio-economic, agricultural and geographical data relevant to solar projects (resource potential, ability and willingness to pay, cropping patterns, etc.)
- Preparing and presenting monthly, quarterly and annual project reports on KPIs and impact indicators to the management
- Following up with vendors/suppliers and transport companies for timely delivery of equipment and goods; keeping track of product and equipment warranties
- Support to ensure delivery of project deliverables on time

Partnerships

- Research, identify and conduct due diligence on local grassroots partners (agricultural NGOs, community organisations, farmer producer organisations, etc.) to assess their relevance and fit with Oorja's mission and activities
- Networking and liaising with other local stakeholders including NGOs, self-help groups, government departments, etc.
- Lead site visits with new partners
- Share insights from partner meetings effectively in team meetings and translate the insights into recommendations and plans

Impact Management

- Provide input into the finalisation of Oorja's monitoring and evaluation design and data collection instruments and tools; develop new tools if required
- Lead impact data collection: conduct individual impact assessment surveys; organise and lead focus group discussions
