Community Consultation on Affordable Housing Meeting January 14th – the meeting was held via Microsoft Teams with 47 attending to hear the update from the Morteheo and Woolacombe Community Land Trust and to see the unveiling of the proposed site for the affordable homes in the Parish. At the end of the meeting, a poll was taken with 98% of those attending indicating support for the project. The scheme is designed for those who live or have strong local connection with the Parish. The houses will be offered at social rent levels and will be protected from sale.
