50 Words for Spelling Bee Officials

cocoon (kuh-koon)
Definition: A silky case spun by some insects for protection during development.
Example Sentence: The caterpillar stayed in its cocoon until it transformed into a butterfly.

combine (kuhm-byin)
Definition: To bring things together into one.
Example Sentence: We need to combine the ingredients to make the cake better.

captain (kap-tin)
Definition: The person in charge of a ship, airplane, or team.
Example Sentence: The captain guided the ship safely through the storm.

armadillo (ahr-muh-dil-oh)
Definition: A small mammal with a protective shell.
Example Sentence: The armadillo rolled into a ball to protect itself.

classroom (klas-room)
Definition: A room in a school where lessons are taught.
Example Sentence: The students sat quietly in the classroom.

landmark (land-mahrk)
Definition: A significant or recognizable object or feature of a landscape.
Example Sentence: The Statue of Liberty is a famous landmark in New York.

ballroom (bawl-room)
Definition: A large room used for dances or formal events.
Example Sentence: The guests gathered in the ballroom for the wedding reception.

blueprint (bloo-print)
Definition: A detailed plan or drawing used to design or build something.
Example Sentence: The architect studied the blueprint before construction began.

clip
Definition: A flat board with a clip of the papers.
Example Sentence: The teacher used a clip on the attendance sheet.

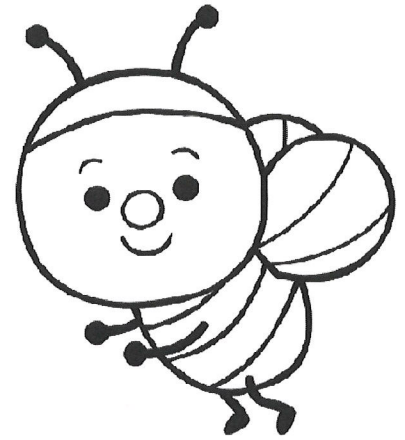

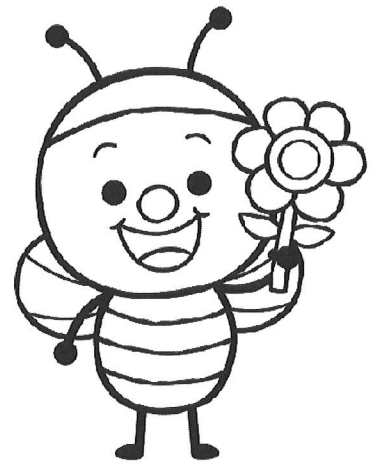

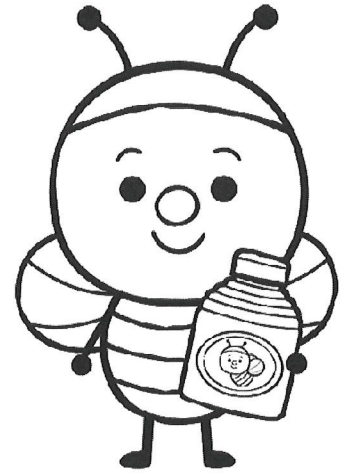
