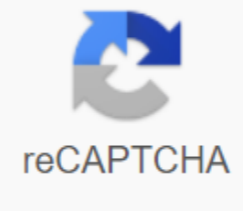

But did you know that it also offers sharable calendars? They allow you to import all kinds of events into the calendar without doing any work on setting them up. Let's look at some of the most useful public (or at least free) calendars that you can add to your Google calendar. With them, you can track almost everything. 1. Google Calendar Holidays has built-in support for all kinds of holidays. To access them, click the Gear icon over the calendar and select settings. On the left side, expand the Add calendar section and select calendars of interest. Here you will see holidays broken by religion, such as Christian holidays and Muslim holidays. You can also expand regional holidays to add calendars for holidays in a huge list of countries. Just check the box for any holiday calendar you would like to add and you'll see it appear on your list of other calendars. If you want to get an idea of what the calendar contains, click the Preview icon (which looks like an eye) to check it out first. 2. Schedule Sports The next integrated option Google Calendar offers allows you to track your favorite sports teams. On the same interest page as described above, you can browse on sports such as baseball, football and hockey. From there, select the league and you can check the boxes for your team. Now you will always know when to cheer them up to victory. 3. Phases of the Moon Our last stop in Google calendars is the interest of the lunar cycle. If you are interested in or just want a little more content to flesh out your lonely calendar, adding that it will let you know when the moon is changing phases. Like all calendars, you'll find it in the bottom right corner of your Calendar page. You can click the three-point menu button to change the color of the calendar, hide it from the list, or change other settings. 4. Schedule eSports Let's break away from the options built into the Google calendar and check out some public calendars from around the Internet further. Maybe you are not interested in sports, but enjoy eSports (video game competitions). In this case you'll be happy to know that you can add esports schedules to the Google calendar too. You will need to find a link for your league of choice. The two popular games to get you started are the Rocket League Esports calendar and the Overwatch League calendar. Both of them allow you to add them to the Google calendar with one click. Note that they are not official, so they may not receive updates for future seasons. 5. The Weather Google Calendar is used to offer weather integration by default, but this is no longer the case. But don't despair; You can still add the weather to the calendar quite easily. In the Google calendar, click the Plus button next to other calendars and select from the URL. On the resulting page, insert the following Weather Underground URL: Replace 12345 with a five-digit zip code, and then click Add Calendar. In a minute, you will see a new event at the top of each day with conditions as well as high and low temperatures. 6. TV shows If you love watching new episodes of your favorite shows once they air, it can be tough tracking when they all come on. Fortunately, you can use some handy websites to add them all to your calendar. Go pogdesign.co.uk/cat/ and you'll see a calendar with a full monthly screening schedule. You need to create an account to save your favorites. Once you've made an account, you'll also want to customize the settings to your liking. Make sure you choose the right time zone; You can customize your preferences as to whether to show the title of the episode as well. From there you can browse the schedule or search for your favorite shows using the bar in the top right direction. When you find a show you want to track, click Add to favorites on your profile page. Import to Google Calendar Repeat this for all the shows you want to track and then hover over the account button and click on the .iCal entry. This will allow you to download a file that provides a limited 2 week review of selected shows. So it's not a long-term solution, but can help in a season when a lot of new shows start. You can add this file to the Google Calendar by clicking on Plus next to other calendars and selecting Imports. View the file on your computer and select it for import. Instead of adding a new calendar, it's add events to your chosen calendar. So you can create a special calendar for TV shows if you don't want to clutter up your core. To keep track of everything you have So far we recommend taking a look at Trakt. 7. Movie releases It's easy to lose count of what's in theaters at the moment. FirstShowing.net you covered the schedule of each film is scheduled for release this year. Click on the 20XX Schedule tab at the top and you can view this year's list of movies. At the top of this year you'll see the Google Calendar button. Clicking on this provides a preview of the calendar; Click the Plus button in the bottom right corner to add it to your own calendar. Find the 2019 movie calendar here. You will need to repeat the process for next year's calendar when it becomes available. While the website's list includes limited-edition movies as well as wide-release movies, Google's calendar only shows those that are shown across the country. 8. Concerts There is nothing worse than to realize one of your favorite bands played a concert in your city... Last week. JamBase helps you avoid this plight by helping you keep track of your favorite groups and those who come to your area. Once you've signed up for an account, check out the shows in your area or look for your favorite bands. After adding upcoming shows to the JamBase calendar, click My JamBase in the top right and select the calendar. Here you can click Add to the Google Calendar. Now all your scheduled concerts are easy to track and you won't miss a show for life ever again. 10. Fictional holidays So you have Father's Day and Christmas in your calendar, but what about the Gondor New Year from The Lord of the Rings? Can you remember when Harry Potter's birthday was? Are you ready to celebrate Festivus this year? If you're not on these holidays, this calendar from Atlas Obscura can help. It details more than 75 fictional holidays, mostly from movies and TV shows that you can celebrate along with real ones. The Roman calendar is the most perfect but designed. She has twelve months. Except when it has thirteen like this year. And all these months have either thirty-one or twenty-nine days. Early farmers couldn't just look at the wall calendar to see how many days before the last frost date. However, knowing that there were about 12 lunar cycles between one spring and the next, they could calculate how many lunar phases remained before the planting. Thus was born the concept of the 354-day lunar calendar, a concept that forever contradicted about 365.25 days of solar year. Mixing the time derived from the movements of the rotating Earth, the earth orbiting the Sun, and the passage of the Moon as a satellite of the Earth is difficult enough, but the Maya had 17 cosmological calendars, some of which were fought ten million years ago and required the services of astronomers, astrologers, geologists and mathematicians to figure out. An introduction to the Mayan calendar terminology provides simplified information about some of the cycles and glyphs used in Mayan calendars. At least once, on March 5, 1953 BC - at the beginning of the Chinese calendar time - all planets, the Sun and moon were aligned. Names for the days of the week (although Teutonic Woden, Tiw, Thor, and Frigg have replaced Roman names for deities of kinship prowess) refer to various celestial bodies. Our 7-day week started on Aug. (See the table below.) In keeping with calendars and their history, calendars allow us to plan our agriculture, hunting, and migratory activities. They can also be used to predict and set dates for religious and civil events. No matter how precise we try to make them, calendars should be judged not by their scientific sophistication, but by how well they serve social needs. Its author believes that the time has come for reforms. Our Gregorian calendar, adopted in 1751 by the Act of Parliament, uses in the same months, two millennia ago, in 45 BC, as a result of the reform of the calendar (4). Caesar encountered an unreliable system of the lunar calendar based on distrust of the villages. The original first month, Martius, had 31 days, as did Mayus, quintilis (later renamed Julius), October and December. All other months had 29 days, except for the last month of the year, which was allowed to be unlucky with only 28 days. (The Aztecs also considered some days of their xihuitl calendar unsuccessful.) After discovering that their calendar did not correspond to the times of the sunny year, the Romans, like the Jews and Sumerians, recalibrated an additional month - whenever the College of The Pontiffs found it necessary (as in an excerpt from the Murder on the Appian Way). Caesar turned to Egypt for guidance with a complex Roman calendar. Ancient Egyptians predicted the annual flood of the Nile based on the appearance of the star Sirius. The period between 365.25 days is less than an hour incorrectly for five years. Thus, by abandoning the Roman lunar calendar, Caesar set alternate months of 31 and 30 days from February, having only 29 days, except for every fourth year when February 23 was repeated. Because the Romans haven't counted since the beginning of the month, and before it. They counted how many days before Nones, Ida, and Kalends each month. February 23 was considered six days before the Kaland of March - the old beginning of the year. When it was repeated, it was called bi-sextilla. What was the format of the Roman Calendar Fasti? The main changes of Pope Gregory XIII were algorithms for calculating moving holidays and a new system of leap years, which got rid of leap years in years that are divided into 100, but not 400. Pope Gregory also removed ten days from the 1592 calendar year in order to place a shift in the equinox. When did we switch from the Roman Calendar to Fasti to the modern one?
