John McAuliff, Democratic nominee for House District 30, Announces over \$130,000 raised in June, Erases Opponent's Cash Advantage

FAUQUIER COUNTY, VA – Today, John McAuliff, Democratic nominee for Virginia's 30th House District, announced that his campaign raised over \$130,000 in June of 2025, outraising all other battleground candidates in Virginia and erasing incumbent Del. Geary Higgins's cash on hand advantage. The campaign raised over \$239,000 in Q2, with over \$141,000 coming from 253 donors across Virginia. The campaign currently has over \$298,000 cash on hand.

"Our fundraising success is a testament to the strong belief people have in our vision for our community," **said McAuliff**. "I am energized by the support that our campaign has received, and am ready to fight for the families, farmers, and small businesses of Fauquier and Loudoun Counties. Our message is resonating across the district, and we're building a movement that is ready to win in November."

McAuliff is a 10th-generation Virginian, and the owner of Chilton House Suites, an inn in Old Town Warrenton. He worked for the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the White House's Office of Clean Energy Innovation & Implementation, where he directed grants to family farms and oversaw the Rural Energy for America Program, creating over 10,000 good paying jobs in rural America. McAuliff previously served as Chief of Staff to Del. David Reid (HD-28).
