

COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

With ongoing concerns presented by COVID 19, it is hoped that everyone is well accustomed to taking maximum health precautions. After careful thought, we will be implementing the following procedures for the Salome, Arizona clinics.

- 1 Common surfaces will be disinfected regularly.
- 2 Hand sanitizer will be available, but you are also encouraged to bring your own. Wipes will be available in the bathrooms before/after use, for your convenience.

Attendees' cooperation with the following will be appreciated:

- 1 Wash hands frequently
- 2 Masks will be required, except during meals.
- 3 You may want to bring along a thermometer to track your temperature
4. Meals and discussions will be outside, and well spaced. If weather is bad, these activities will move to the bunkhouse/kitchen with appropriate spacing .
5. People who travel together may share a room. We encourage everyone who has their own LQ to bring it.
6. Please be sensitive to others personal space. 6' social distancing is recommended.
7. Please plan on bringing foodstuffs that require minimal refrigeration. Every effort will be made to provide room in the kitchen for your food prep, but it may not be possible to offer this amenity.

It is our fervent hope that you and your horse enjoy good health prior to, during and following your Arizona clinic. If you are feeling ill prior to your clinic week, please do not attempt to make the trip! If you start to feel ill during your clinic week, please notify Harry immediately. While the above guidelines are put in place in an abundance of caution, please be aware that we are not responsible for anyone's safety or health issue of any kind, including COVID-19. Have a plan.
